MEET OUR JUDGES

EDGAR BAJONA

I've been licensed by the Canadian Kennel Club and judging dogs for the last twenty four years in Canada. I have also judged in the United States, Australia, Argentina, Brazil, Chili, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ireland, Mexico, Moscow and New Zealand. Also judged at the World Show in Argentina in (2005)



As far back as I can remember I have had dogs. At sixteen years of age I had an Airedale Terrier and an American Cocker Spaniel.

I was born in Malta, Europe and showed dogs prior to moving to Canada in 1961. I purchased my first Afghan hound in 1969, and bred my first litter in 1974. By 1987 we had produced over 30 Canadian and American Champions.

We also bred Standard Longhaired Dachshunds under the JAGAR prefix. Also breed and exhibit Schnauzer (Miniature) and Poodles (Standard and Toys).

Life time member of the Canadian Kennel Club. Member of the Afghan Hound Club of Canada. Worked on club recognition, and Dog show representative for CKC Western zone Ontario.

My hobbies include traveling and Ballroom and Latin American Dancing.

KATELON BAJONA-FOX

Katelon Bajona-Fox, CMG, started breeding and showing toy poodles in 1974. She quickly fell in love with the sport and in 1980 went onto breeding Standard Poodles and later Smooth Mini Dachshunds in 1987. She also developed a liking for terriers and in 1989 started breeding Wire Fox Terriers and Mini Schnauzers. As of today she still has toy and standard poodles, along with Mini Schnauzers.



LOKODI CSABA ZSOLT

As a child I was surrounded by dogs as my parents have bred Hungarian Puli under the name of "Regeni kennel" since 1973. However, I did not maintain the family tradition in breeding Hungarian Puli and I purchased my first Airedale Terrier in the middle of the 1980's, a breed I admired whenever I caught sight of them at the dogshows of the 80's.



Thus, in 1988 I founded my own kennel under the name of "Nyaradmenti". As years were passing Airedale Terriers were followed by Wirehaired Dachshunds beginning with 1989, and in 1990 I imported in Romania the first Welsh Terrier named Villamgyors Bella.

Unfortunately at the beginning of the 90's the quality of Airedale Terriers in our country was so low that even the imported males could not improvinge the breed. So in the middle of the 90's l imported a few females from different bloodlines (Lutrahazi, van't Asbroek, Aluzija, etc) and in 1999 also the famous male Am Ch Terrydale HK Shaireab Online as a new bloodline founder.

While we still had to face some problems with the Airedales, the quality of the Welsh Terriers produced in my kennel was showing an ascending tendency towards modern lines. Big stars of the breed in that period were Nyaradmenti Caper, Nyaradmenti Gupi, Nyaradmenti Gina, Nyaradmenti Jill's, Nyaradmenti Summertime, names that can be found in all the pedigrees of Welsh Terriers born in Romania. I kept a Wirehaired Dachshund as a family dog, that is why I had few litters but all of very good quality, marking the Dachshund breed in Romania.

Here I'd like to mention Nyaradmenti Ibis Ribis, Nyaradmenti Idiot Icik (the father of the BOB in the European Dogshow Poznan). At present I breed miniature wirehaired dachshunds. At the beginning of 2000 we gathered our forces with the young kennel of Happytails. This co-operation lasted till

GENERAL

INFORMATION

 No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.

- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE 8:00 P.M. WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1, 2015 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 6. Identification Cards and Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification Cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- 7. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.
- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. The Guelph & District Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. Friday, April 17, Saturday, April 18 and Sunday, April 19, 2015. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule.
- 6. SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of the Show Building.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards:Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

2008, and as a result at the above mentioned 3 breeds we obtained world quality dogs with positive echoes in dog shows in USA, Australia, Russia and Europe.

MAVIS MCCLINTOCK

I was born and raised in Winnipeg and got my first show dog, a Samoyed, in 1969. Ch, OTCh Fiala Regina was the first of many Samoyeds and Labradors who filled my home. Under the kennel name of Samador, which I registered in 1972, they were all extensively exhibited in Conformation and Obedience with many show champions and obedience titled dogs, including two UDs.



In 1990, while living in the British Virgin Islands, I met and fell hopelessly in love with the Portuguese Water Dog and in 1992 Ch Neocles Lord Nelson

CD came into my life. Nelson was one of the first PWDs in Canada to achieve a championship and obedience title and was the first of many PWDs and handful of Lowchens to share our home - all of which achieved conformation and obedience and/or water trial titles. I now breed only PWDs and have been fortunate to breed Best In Show, multiple BPIS, Specialty BOS and Puppy winners, many group and puppy group winners as well as rally, agility, obedience and water trial winners.

For more 45 years I have been dedicated to working in my Provincial and National breed clubs and I am proud of being the first PWD breeder/judge in Canada. I have been fortunate to travel to Europe and Finland for numerous World Shows and attended the first World Congress on the Portuguese Water Dog in Portugal in 2013.

My passion for dogs and the conformation ring is boundless and the opportunity to judge is a great joy. I am licensed for the entire working group and the first half of the non sporting breeds and on permit for the second half. I have judged PWD specialties in the USA and Canada.

THOMAS EDWARD NESBITT

I have always loved dogs and got smitten by the conformation world when I bought my first show dog, a Siberian Husky, in 1968. The breed proved more challenging than I expected and that led me to fall in love with American Cockers buying my first cocker in 1982. I thought she was beautiful but quickly was made aware that Misty was not a show dog! But I dearly loved her so I got involved with obedience and put my first CD on a pure bred dog. I then obtained another American Cocker (Parti-Colour),



this time with show potential and ultimately she became my first Canadian Champion and was the basis of my breeding program in American Cockers. In 1993, David Swartwood, my partner, moved to Canada. He introduced me to the wonderful world of English Springers (Bryden prefix) (the joy of his life and they grew on me rather quickly)! We also launched ourselves into the world of miniature wire-haired dachshunds which we breed and show under the prefix of Prelude. We have owned and shown English Springer Spaniels, Wire and Smooth Dachshunds, American Cocker Spaniels, English Bulldogs, Siberian Huskies, Dalmatians, and a Pug. We are proud to say that Prelude Dachshunds and Bryden Springers are being shown in many countries around the world including the United States, Mexico, Indonesia, Australia, New Zealand, Brazil, Italy and Spain.

In 1994 I began my judging career when I earned my license for the Sporting Group. I am now licensed as a Canadian Kennel Club all-breed judge. I have enjoyed the privilege of judging in many countries including: Australia, Argentina, Brazil, Bermuda, the Bahamas, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Indonesia, Ireland, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand and the United States.

I am a theologian by training having graduated McGill University and seminary in Montreal. Now retired, my career was in Health Care Palliative Care Counselling. I also had the pleasure of serving as the National Executive Director of Canadian Guide Dogs for the Blind.
