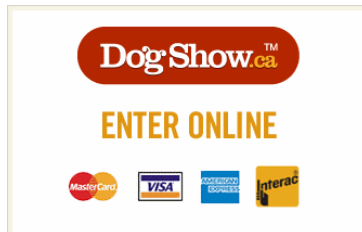

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. A bronze study of Ch. Holweit's Robin The Bank, mounted on an Oak base, to be awarded to the Best of Breed Winner at the Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier Association of Canada's National Specialty. The winner will be presented with a Commemorative Study. For permanent possession the trophy shall be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy is to remain in the possession of Sylvia and Bill Hamilton or their designate until retired.

BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SPECIALTY

Maureen Holmes Trophy, 16-inch sterling silver reverse bowl, will be awarded to the Best Canadian-Bred in Specialty. A rosette will also be offered. A donation to the AKC/CHF Health Fund will be made by the donors, Emily Holden and Carol Carlson in

the name of the owner and the dog. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won five times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy will remain in the possession of Carol Carlson or her designate until retired.

VIVIENNE LINDSAY MEMORIAL TROPHY

Dr. Robert Lindsay and Tyrone Wheatens are pleased to offer the "*Vivienne Lindsay Memorial Trophy*" to the highest placing owner-handled Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier at the 2016 Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier Association of Canada's National Specialty. The trophy will be engraved and retained by the donors and a prize presented to the winner.

THE TYRONE BEST OF WINNERS TROPHY

A Wheaten bronze mounted on a maple base, to be awarded to the SCWT placed as Best of Winners at the Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier Association of Canada's National Specialty. The winner will be presented with a Commemorative keeper trophy. For permanent possession the trophy shall be won six times by the same owner. The trophy is to remain in the possession of Lana Campbell and John Slack or their designate until retired.

MYSHAWNS WHEATEN AMBASSADOR AWARD

The Myshawns Wheaten Ambassador Award is offered annually by the SCWTAC through the generosity of Margaret Stewardson (Myshawns Wheatens) in Memory of "Shawnie". The award is presented to the Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier from those proposed that best meets the criteria for this award as selected by a committee of three individuals chaired by Margaret Stewardson. The committee will include as a minimum one member of the SCWTAC board. The award will be presented at the AGM/Dinner held in conjunction with the National Specialty.

Eligibility: To be considered for this award a Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier must be proposed in writing by a member of the SCWTAC. The proposed dog must also be owned by a SCWTAC member and be registered with the CKC.

Proposed candidates will be accepted up to 4 weeks prior to the date of the National Specialty in the year of the award.

Criteria: Dogs from all countries are eligible providing they are registered with the CKC and owned by a member of the SCWTAC. A minimum of 3 titles must have been achieved from different areas of competition (i.e. conformation, obedience, pet therapy, agility, etc.). The level of difficulty of each title will be evaluated and rated accordingly. Involvement in community activities will be a major consideration. To propose a Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier for 2016, submit name of proposed dog and owner along with copies of CKC registration and all titles received and a resume of the dog's accomplishments not to exceed 500 words by June 30 to:

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in both Sweepstakes. 25% of the entry fees shall be retained by the club for expenses, with the remaining entry money divided as follows:

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

All Sweepstakes Entries must be **Breeder or Owner Handled**. To compete in any Sweepstakes class, dogs must be entered in a Regular class. Entry from Exhibition Only is not allowed.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs <u>owned and handled in the ring by the breeder</u> for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades – but they may compete in Sweepstakes if a 3-6 month class is offered.</u>
BABY PUPPY	dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points. Puppies in this category may compete in Sweepstakes if a 3-6 month class is offered.
BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.
ALTERED	Open to dogs who have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ERRORS IN ENTRIES

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

Attention Canadian Exhibitors!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is \$59.40 + 5% GST.**
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7
5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level
