



For any Afghan Hound, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Italian Greyhound, Irish Wolfhound, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound or Whippet that is one year of age or older on the date of the trial. All entrants must be registered with, or eligible for registration with, the Canadian Kennel Club. Hounds with breed disqualifications, altered or neutered are eligible. - The owner of the filed requests all competitors or spectators not to bring a bitch in season onto the grounds. Please respect this for the sake of all entered males. Please check your bitches before leaving home.
- Entry fee for all bitches in season and lame hounds will be refunded .provided notice is given at or before Roll Call
- Hounds not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee not refunded.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has happened.
- Only the 1st place winner of the Mixed Stake may compete in Best in Field.
- A \$5.00 fine will be levied against the owner of any hound loose on the field.
