"Manitoba's Top Dog" – awards will be presented to each of the Top Placing Dogs in 2016 in Conformation, Rally and Obedience, owned/co-owned by a Manitoban. Criteria – points are gathered throughout the 2016 calendar year at CKC shows throughout Canada. The dog must be shown at least three times in Manitoba to qualify. Point accumulation starts when the dog is registered as owned by a resident of Manitoba in the competition year.

"Manitoba's Top Puppy" – awards will be presented to the Top Placing Puppy in 2016, owned/co-owned by a Manitoban. Criteria – points are gathered throughout the 2016 calendar year at CKC shows throughout Canada. The dog must be shown at least three times in Manitoba to qualify. Point accumulation starts when the dog is registered as owned by a resident of Manitoba in the competition year.

"Manitoba Top Group Placers" – awards will be presented to the Top Placing Dog in each Group in 2015, owned by a Manitoban. Criteria – points are gathered throughout the 2015 calendar year at CKC shows throughout Canada. The dog must be shown at least three times in Manitoba to qualify. Point accumulation starts when the dog is registered as owned by a resident of Manitoba in the competition year.

"Manitoba's Top Breeder/Owner/Handler" will receive an award to commemorate their accomplishment. Accumulated points are based upon Conformation points as per Canuck Dogs, and if applicable, Obedience points – 10% of a passing score, Rally points – 10% of a passing score. You must be listed as the breeder and owner/co-owner on the current CKC registration papers and must have exclusively handled this dog throughout the calendar year. Dogs that are co-owned may be handled by either or both owners. The dog must be shown at least three times in Manitoba to qualify. Point accumulation starts when the dog is registered as owned by the breeder/owner who is a resident of Manitoba in the competition year. Winners are asked to email their summary standings for 2015 to PawsForCelebrationManitoba@gmail.com by Feb 15., 2017.

Breed Winners Placing in the Top 5 of their Breed in Canada will receive an award to commemorate their accomplishment. Winners are asked to email their final placements in the breed standing for 2016 to PawsForCelebrationManitoba@gmail.com by Feb 15, 2017. Criteria – points are gathered throughout the 2016 calendar year at CKC shows throughout Canada. The dog must be shown at least once in Manitoba to qualify. Point accumulation starts when the dog is registered as owned by a resident of Manitoba in the competition year.

"CCN Award" – award will be presented to the Top Ranking Mixed Breed Dog with a CCN number. Ranking is based upon accumulated scores in performance events with a single dog over the 2016 season. All qualifying scores along with the show name and date should be submitted to PawsForCelebrationManitoba@gmail.com. by Feb 15., 2017 to qualify.

"Lifetime Contribution Award" – will be presented to an outstanding Manitoban who has dedicated themselves to the betterment and celebration of our sport of purebred dogs. Submissions for this award will be accepted at PawsForCelebrationManitoba@gmail.com. A short narrative of the nominee's contributions and accomplishments in the world of purebred dogs should be included. Submissions will be accepted until January 15, 2017.
