- Bitches in season will not be eligible to compete and are not allowed on the test grounds.
- Ducks, pheasants, and/or chukars may be used.
- Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs who pass the test.
- A draw for running order will be held at the home of the Test Chair.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- By attending this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that Pacific Rim Hunting Retriever Club, test officials and landowners involved do not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by exhibitors, dogs or spectators.

## Swallowfield Estuary

### Directions to Headquarters:

Swallowfield Road is North of Duncan and South of Chemainus. Turn East off of the #1 Trans-Canada Highway onto Mt. Sicker Road. Follow Mt. Sicker Road to the T-junction, and then turn Left onto Chemainus Road. When you reach Crofton Road stay left, and after about 100m turn right onto Swallowfield Road (look for the PRHRC sign). Drive through the gate, proceed until you reach the T-junction, and then turn right to proceed to the Headquarters, at the Hydroxyl field area.

PRHRC signs will help guide the way.

If travelling from the mainland, **reservations on BC Ferries are recommended.** The nearest terminal is Duke Point if travelling from Tsawwassen. Go to [www.bcferrries.com](http://www.bcferrries.com) Please only enter if travel to Vancouver Island is allowed by the Provincial Health Officer guidelines.

### **COVID Hunt Test Information**

These guidelines may be altered or amended before the test, as per current PHO recommendations.

- Parking - Please leave more space between your vehicles, *within reason*.
- All participants need to bring ALL their own supplies.
- Practice social distancing. Maintain a MINIMUM of 2 meters distance between you and other participants, *at all times*. Don't be offended if someone reminds you to step back!
- Bring your own water and soap for hand washing and your own hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes. We will have some hand sanitizer, bleach wipes and a wash station there, but people need to plan to provide for themselves because of the difficulty in procuring some of these items.
- All judges, workers and handlers should use proper hand washing, be conscious of respiratory etiquette and avoid borrowing others equipment.
- You are welcome to wear a mask. Masks may be removed at the line. The judges will ensure that they are well back of the handler, when the whistle or duck calls are being used.
- Do not shake hands or give hugs!
- There will be a designated area for airing your dogs. Please pick up after your dog, especially in any parking areas or along the road where the public walks. There will be moving vehicles, so please keep your dogs on leash.
- Please avoid petting other people's dogs.
- There will be a designated area for the gallery. Please maintain the 2 meters distance from anyone who is not in your household or in your social bubble.
- If you have any questions, they must be directed to the Marshal. Please do not come to talk to the judges at the line.
- While the test dog is running, please be very conscious of not crowding the line. Individually, you can come up to the running line to look at the test. Please wait your turn and do not move to the line until the previous person is over 2 meters away.
- Please bring your own duck calls, for use at the line. *Absolutely no sharing*.
- The handlers will place the bird in a pail or on a bird rack. Judges will not take them from the handlers. If the judge needs to check a bird, they will do so after the handler has left the line.
- If you are Marshalling, please bring all your own radio. A clipboard and pen will be provided.
- Please be sure to pick up and take ALL your belongings (AND GARBAGE) at the end of the day. It is imperative that personal items not be left behind.
- There will be no Saturday night dinner.
- There is no camping at Westholme School. Please contact one of the listed campgrounds.
