**ELIGIBILITY:** These tests are open to all Dachshunds and those CKC recognized Terriers in Group IV and the Miscellaneous list seeking eligibility for Group IV small enough to navigate a 9 inch drain. Dogs must be 6 months or older.

**ENTRY LIMIT:** Entries will be Limited as follows for each test 20 Introductory To Quarry , 25 Junior Earth Dog and 15 Senior Earth Dog Entries. Entries are accepted on a first come , first served basis.

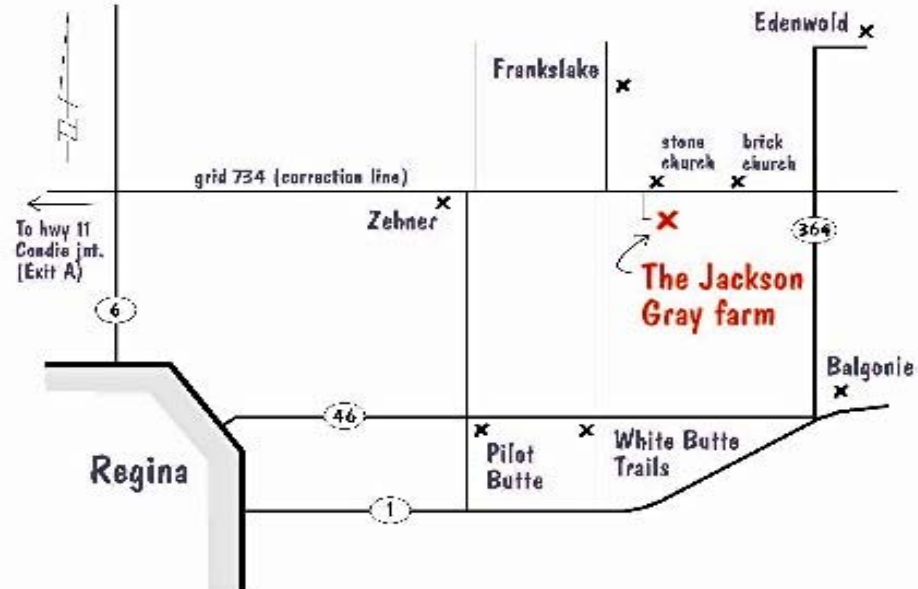

**BITCHES IN SEASON:**

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the Tests. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

**Event Registration Number (Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog):**

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee along with the completed application form. **Non-Member Participation Fee :**

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The fee will match the ERN fee. In Order to protect the awards/titles , the non-member will have a choice of becoming a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

**General Rules**

- 1 Correct Entry Information on Entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant.
2. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by the disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$25.00 service charge will levied on All NSF cheques.
- 3.All dogs must be kept under control at all times and exercised in the posted designated area. It is expected that all exhibitors will pick up after their dogs.
- 4 It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a Judge, Club Official, Volunteer, or Any Participant at an Earth Dog Test held under these regulations, is not subject to **any Indignities**. The Earth Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
