Location: Richmond Rod & Gun Club, 7891 Cambie Rd., Richmond, BC.

Note – we are NOT at Albion Fairgrounds!

Covid and other diseases are still with us and new cases are still showing up in the province. DON'T COME IF YOU AREN'T FEELING WELL OR IF YOU HAVE TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID WITHIN 5 DAYS. Handlers will receive a refund of entry fees if they have tested positive for Covid, have Covid symptoms or if this event is cancelled due to changes to BC Provincial Health Officers orders or guidelines in effect closer to the event. Handlers are welcome and encouraged to wear masks during check in and indoors.

Parking: Parking may be a bit tighter than at the Maple Ridge venue. There are aerial photos at the end of this document that show where you can park. People running dogs can park in the green zones only. The blue RV boxes indicate where we will have RVs parked as visual barriers, not where you can park your RV. We will have a volunteer to help you with parking. Do what she says.

Check in & walkthrough: Check in times for each level are listed in the schedule. We expect everyone to be there for these even if you are only running in 1 component. If you arrive late, we may not be able to accommodate a separate walk through for you.

Potty areas: Dogs can potty on the west side and south sides of the property only. There's a lovely walking trail along the river across River Road. Don't walk past the north edge of the venue parking lot. A human restroom will be available inside.

Other stuff that doesn't fit anywhere else: Food and beverages are available within walking distance at Tim Horton's and Aberdeen Centre. We will have the wonderful Leanne Whynot taking photographs each day. She's very dog aware and if you choose to not have her taking photos during your run just say so and no hard feelings. She'll post where the photos will be available after the event.

Etiquette: Dogs must be kept on a 6' or shorter leash while in the general area of the trial grounds (i.e. the area around the parking lot) including the potty area and going to and from searches. To ensure the safety of your dogs, please keep at least 8' between dogs.

More etiquette: Handlers are responsible for the comfort of their dogs. Please bring sufficient shade and water. It promises to be over 20°C on both days and there is no shade in the parking lot. There will be no indoor crating. **Dogs must be contained within handlers' vehicles when not going potty or to and from search areas. Handlers may sit outside next**

to their vehicles but dogs must be crated outside or contained within the vehicle attached. No dogs in x-pens outside of vehicles. There will be no loose dogs or dogs playing in the parking lot. **ANYONE DISOBEYING THESE RULES WILL BE EXCUSED AND TOLD TO LEAVE WITH NO REFUND.**

Ribbons: Because of the warm temperature, you may pick up your ribbon from the secretary when your runs are over and you may leave. Please wait until the gate steward says you can go in and respect teams that are running. The judge's debrief and general distribution of ribbons will be at the lunch break for Instinct, Novice & Excellent and at the end of the trial for Open and Master.
