- The entry of a dog at a trial must be accompanied by the entry fee. Conditional entries or entries accompanied by post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
 - CKC Rule 6.1.6 no dog may be entered in any class for which it is not eligible at the time entries for the trial close.
 - The club must reject an incomplete entry form and promptly return it to whoever submitted it, be it the owner, lessee, or authorized agent.
 - Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. A collection fee of \$25 will be added to any returned cheque.
 - CKC Rule 4.4.2..... Once an advertised trial limit has been reached, entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than a bitch being in season and those on the reserve list who did not participate in the trial.
 - CKC Rule 6.5.2 Entry fees will be refunded for a bitch in season providing the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

Rules & Regulations: It is the responsibility of each competitor to be familiar with and abide by the Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2024 which can be found on the CKC website, WWW.CKC.ca

Discipline: Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club reserves the right to remove any person from these trials. The Trial Chair shall have full control of this event which will be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club rules. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a trial held under the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Females In Season: When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian’s certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the Trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded.

Non-Member Participation Fee: Canadian Resident non-CKC members competing with a wholly owned dog cannot win an award or title unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Change of Entry: A dog may be moved from one official class to another within the same trial. A dog that has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules, may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the Trial Secretary on the appropriate form by the owner or handler AT LEAST THIRTY MINUTES PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TRIAL.

Rules Governing These Trials

1. Dogs must be always kept under control and on leash within the building except in the obedience ring.
2. Collars other than those specified in these rules are not allowed within the venue. Violation of this rule may result in removal of the dog from further competition at the trial.
3. Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club will use all reasonable care to ensure the safety of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, loss or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during these trials.
4. If for any reason beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the trials no refund of entry fees will be made.
5. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called.
6. Any dog entered and received at an obedience trial must compete in all exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, superintendent, or the trial chair, or request of HLR option.
7. Eligibility to enter specific obedience classes is detailed in the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations. Entrants should review these requirements before entering the trials to ensure they are entered in the correct class. Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club will not be held responsible for incorrect entries.
8. Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: Registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration, Performance Event, or Canine Companion, number; have a Temporary Competition number if eligible for registration with the CKC; have a Miscellaneous Certification number if it belongs to a CKC listed breed.
9. No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: -
 - I. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
 - II. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event).
 - III. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.
10. Please keep the building and grounds clean. Please pick up after your dog.

CLASSIFICATION – OBEDIENCE

PRE-NOVICE

The Pre-Novice class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of PCD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all five exercises unless they have two or more dogs entered. In such cases, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of CD may enter the Pre-Novice class.

NOVICE A

The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under Section 10.1.4. No person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

NOVICE

The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless they have two or more dogs entered. In such cases, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

NOVICE C

The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless they have two or more dogs entered. In such cases, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE

The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

OPEN HA & OPEN 18A

The Open A classes shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD but has not earned the title of CDX. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in these classes and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned an OTCH title may not handle a dog in these classes. When a dog is wrongfully entered in these classes, any score awarded will be cancelled. No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial.

OPEN HB & OPEN 18B

The Open B classes shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD. Dogs that have earned the title of CDX or any higher obedience titles may enter either of the Open B classes. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. Dogs in these classes may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in these classes. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven exercises unless they have two or more dogs entered. In such case, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise(s). Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed for Open HB and Open 18B. These choices will not be disclosed to exhibitors until they are posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of each class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines, so they will be used approximately the same number of times. No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial.

UTILITY A

The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX but has not earned the title of OTCH. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

UTILITY B

The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX or OTCH. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial.

EXHIBITION ONLY

This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only, which is an official class that must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any regular class; however, it may be entered in and compete in any unofficial class or parade offered at the trial on payment of the prescribed fees
