CKC RULE 4.6.1 – INDIGNITIES TO A JUDGE

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Further, this rule also includes a club official, volunteer, or any participant at our events.

PLEASE NOTE: No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$25.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the KAOS Dogsports Inc. of Regina Inc. (Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted). Overpayment of entry fees will be gratefully accepted as a donation to our trophy fund.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Open Classes	There are four (4) Open Classes: The Open HA and Open HB classes, which include the Out of Sight Group Stay Exercises and the Open 18 A and Open 18B classes, which include the Changes of Position and Group Sit – Walk Around Exercises. NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN MORE THAN ONE OPEN CLASS AT ANY ONE TRIAL.
Open HA and Open 18A Effective January 1, 2018	The Open A classes shall be for any dogs of any recognized or listed breeds, mixed breeds or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in these classes, and that person must handle the dogs in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in these classes. When a dog is wrongfully entered in these classes, any score awarded will be cancelled
Open HB and Open 18B Effective January 1, 2018	The Open B Classes shall be for any dogs of any recognized or listed breeds, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher obedience titles may enter either of the Open B Class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in these classes may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in these classes. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has more than 2 dogs entered. In such cases, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in group exercise(s). Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed for Open HB and Open 18B, and which sequence of positions is to be performed in the Change of Positions Exercise in the Open 18B class (in the Open 18A class only sequence (a) will be performed). These choices will not be disclosed to exhibitors until they are posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of each class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines and the six position-change sequences so that each routine and sequence will be used approximately the same number of times.

Utility B	
Exhibition Only	This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only, which is an official class that must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any regular class, it may however be entered in and compete in any unofficial class offered at the trial on payment of the prescribed fees. If applicable, a listing fee is required. However, a listing fee is not required for a listed dog entered in Exhibition Only (not entered for any competition).

Obedience Trial Rules

6.5.2 – When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the trial giving club must refund the entry fee and listing fee providing the trial secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian’s certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

6.7.6 – A dog that bites or attempts to bite another dog or a person outside the ring may be removed from the trial by the Trial Committee Chair.

20.7 – It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it seems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

1 – The Obedience Sanctioned Match Chairperson is in complete charge of the Sanctioned Match

2 – No dog will be allowed in the building or on the grounds unless entered in the Sanctioned Match.

3 – No dog is to be left off leash at any time on or near the grounds of the Sanctioned Match except in the obedience ring.

Violations of this rule can result in dismissal from competition. No refund shall be made.

4 – Exhibitor must wear the correct armband while in the ring.

General Instructions

- 1 – No dog will be allowed to compete unless entry fees have been paid in full.
- 2 – Refunds will not be made after the closing date for dogs that do not compete under section 6.5.2 of the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.
- 3 – The Sanctioned Match Committee has the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 4 – The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, either to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 5 – A judge officiating at the Sanctioned Match under Obedience Trial Regulations and Standards shall not be subject to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the Sanctioned Match. It shall be the duty of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Sanctioned Match Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rule. The Board of Directors shall have the power to take action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating this rule has been violated.
- 6 – If because of a riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Sanctioned Match giving club, it is impossible to open or to complete the Sanctioned Match, no refund of entries will be made.
- 7 – Fees must accompany your entries. Tendering a NSF cheque shall be considered an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$ 25.00 fee charged for any NSF cheque issued. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. Over payments will be donated to the club trophy fund.

8 - The Following Temporary Allowable Obedience Rules Changes will be followed:

- The handler will place their leash etc., in a designated spot and pick it up at the end of their run. A ring steward will not bring your leash to you. your dog must leave the ring on leash and under control
- Utility handlers please bring tongs as you may be required to handle your own articles.
- Paper Cards and score sheets may be left on a table for handlers to pick up if they wish at the end of their class. The Judge may announce scores and placements at the end of each class. There may be no award presentations in the ring.
- Pylons will be used for figure 8 posts at all levels
- Group stays - dogs may be placed a minimum of 8 feet apart at all levels. A dog who fails to qualify any of the individual exercises is not eligible to compete in the group exercises.

COVID-19 Information (subject to change)

- All Province of Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) regulations will be followed.
- If you are exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19, please do not attend the Sanctioned Match.
- Any handler unable to attend this match due to COVID-19 after entries close, will be refunded. Proof of COVID related absence will be required.
- Judges, volunteers and exhibitors may wear masks. We encourage mask wearing and respect everyone's choice to wear or not wear a mask. We will also follow any SHA guidelines changes.
- A limited number of spectators, at the discretion of the Chair and Secretary, will be allowed in the building during each class. We will be following any and all SHA guidelines.
- We ask that exhibitors leave following their last class entered, if not volunteering or otherwise helping with the sanctioned match whenever possible.
- There will be limited indoor benching available during your class. You may bring a crate in during your class and remove it when your class is complete. **Contact the Sanctioned Match secretary if you require benching for any longer times. We will accommodate as space is available.**
