**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, cheques will not be accepted.

**NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL.** Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this Trial is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

**ROSETTES & PRIZES:** A Rosette and Prize will be awarded to all New Novice Titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive ribbons (flat).

**THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES OR OVERPAYMENT:** Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Scent Detection comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada will refund entry, recording and listing fees (not the 10% dogshow program service fee) if the above conditions are met. A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a Veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

**BITCHES IN SEASON:** Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

**HANDLERS WITH MULTIPLE DOGS:** Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than one dog in the same class / components. I.e.: Two novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in Novice at the same trial. The handler may enter one dog in Instinct, and one dog in Novice as an alternative.

**TEST SITE:** No indoor kenneling. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test (where off leash searches are permitted). Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site. Remember that this is a public facility used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event.

**WASHROOM FACILITIES:** Facilities are available indoors.

**LUNCH:** Please join our lunch for a small donation to the Rat Terrier Club. Complimentary coffee, tea, and water will be available during the trial.

**CKC REGULATION:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Tel: 1- 800-250-8040.

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Purebred or mixed-breed dogs

Every dog entered in an approved event or sanctioned match must be one of the following: a) Registered with the CKC b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN) c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN) d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) e) (e breed f) Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

To be eligible to compete at approved trials or sanctioned matches a dog must meet the requirements of Section 6.1.1, and: a) Must be at least 6 months of age. b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked. c) Must not be lame (it is the judge's responsibility to determine whether a dog is lame). d) Must not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability (such a dog must be immediately excused and under no circumstances may it be returned later for judging after the tape or bandages have been removed).

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number, provided that: a) If born in Canada, it is eligible for individual CKC registration b) If not born in Canada it is eligible for individual registration in the records of the CKC c) If it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first trial entered d) The entry of a dog with a Temporary Competition Number at a Scent Detection event held under these rules (sanctioned matches excluded), must be accompanied by the appropriate Temporary Competition fees. Breeds of dogs on the miscellaneous list may not be entered using a Temporary Competition Number but must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN). Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds also may not be entered using a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) but must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN).

**SIZE CLASSIFICATIONS:**

The following CKC Size Classification apply:

**Small Dogs** Dogs under 13 inches (33 cm)

**Medium Dogs** Dogs 13 inches (33 cm) and under 20 inches (50.8 cm)

**Large Dogs** Dogs under 20 inches (33 cm) and over

**INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA:**

To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations as set out by the CKC apply.
2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
3. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7 5.
4. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

**WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:**

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.
