# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### Judging Schedules will be emailed and posted online

All exhibitors are required to ensure that their dogs eliminate in designated areas inside and outside the building. All feces MUST be picked up and indoor urination cleanedup thoroughly - supplies will be available.

#### This specialty operates under the CKC Conformation Show Rules. As per these rules, the following sections are published here:

# **19 Discipline**

**19.7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

### 15.1 Championship Points

15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
POINTS ALLOCATED	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

# **NEW Rule**

### **Non-Member Participation Fee**

24.12.3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".
