Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January - December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES

Chapter 13, Section 10 of the Dog Show Rules State:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry. Notice of withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Show Secretary on or before the official closing date as published in the premium list.

MOVING A DOG TO THE SPECIALS CLASS

Chapter 13, Section 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is "INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED AT TIME OF CLOSING" in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW by the owner or handler.

All puppies between the age of 6 and 18 months on the day of the sweepstake are eligible to compete, regardless of place of birth. All puppies entered in the sweepstake must be entered in one of the official regular classes of the breed show that day. Money received as entry fee for the sweepstake will be pooled and divided as follows:

- 1. Building will accept dogs and equipment after 5:00 pm Thursday up until 11:00 pm
- Building will open at 7:00 am Friday, Saturday and Sunday and close at 11:00 pm on Friday and Saturday. Exhibitors must vacate the building 1 hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
- 3. Intransit area available.
- 4. ALL EXERCISE PENS MUST HAVE PLASTIC SHEETING UNDERNEATH AND UP THE SIDES. IF SPACE IS LIMITED, EXERCISE PENS WILL HAVE TO BE TAKEN DOWN DURING SHOW HOURS as requested by the Show Superintendent.
- To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.
- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.
- 7. TELEPHONE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 8. DIANA EDWARDS SHOW SERVICES, reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.


ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS
