Running order is by random draw within each test level.

Refunds will be given for bitches in season. A veterinarian certificate must be submitted prior to the trial.

GENERAL INFORMATION

No entry can be accepted unless and until all particulars called for on the entry form are completed thereon, and accompanied by the full entry fee. Incomplete entries cannot be accepted and may be returned to the exhibitor.

It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date.

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club we are unable to accept, cancel or substitute any entry reaching the Trial Secretary after the closing date and time.

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Canada, its officers and associates will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Trial Superintendent will be in complete charge of the trials which will be governed by the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC).

The trial precincts shall be the non-residential building and non-private areas of main facility plus surrounding grounds of Perfect Scents K9 Boarding & Training Facility.

There is limited indoor space in the lobby for crating. Some tenting will be provided outside. There is plenty of area outside for exhibitors to erect their own shelters if they wish to do so.

TROPHY LIST:

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all teams who qualify.

A New Title Collar Tag will be awarded for SDN, SDO, SDE and SDM.

CKC SCENT DETECTION RULES AND REGULATIONS:

4.1.5(m): "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any

infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

In order for a team to qualify, both the dog and handler must be working together as a team and must be able to read each other's reactions. Communication and praise of the dog during the search are encouraged in a CKC scent detection event.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trail held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an Event Registration Number (ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is not fee for the TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$11.30) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Day of Trial Entries: Time permitting, Day of Trial entries will be accepted for Saturday, June 1, 2024 trial only. Entries with full payment in accordance with the trial's fee schedule must be handed to the Trial Secretary or official designated assistant at least one hour before the start of the Saturday trial. Day of Entries – "CASH Only".

Limited Entry: When the advertised limit of the trial has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a wait list. The person who made the entry will be notified of his position on the list. In the event that the entry of a bitch in season is withdrawn after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the wait list up to and including the day of the event. If the Trial Secretary is notified in writing after the closing date that an entry other than a bitch in season will be absent from the trial, the entry maybe substituted with one from the wait list up to 24 hours prior to the event. Fees will not be refunded for any reason other than a bitch being in season and to those on the wait list who did not participate in the event. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the trial for those on the wait list who did not participate in the trial.
