She has judged all breed, specialty and FCI International shows in Australia, Canada, China, Great Britain, Italy, Japan, the Philippines, New Zealand, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Switzerland and the USA, including Hawaii. Dr. Forsythe's passion for purebred dogs began in 1967, showing working and gun dogs. In 1975, she registered "Lionheart" with the Canadian Kennel Club. She bred MBIS winning Chow Chows for 25 years, MBIS Pekingese for 15 years, and World Dog Show winning Japanese Chin since 2007. In 2006, Dr. Forsythe was honoured with an AKC Outstanding Sportsmanship award. She continues to breed and show her Chow Chow, Pekingese and Japanese Chin in Canada, the USA and at World Dog Shows. "Lionheart" has attained #1

ranking with over 150 Championship titles in 10 countries. Dr. Forsythe is a practicing lawyer and mediator. She served as President of the Japanese Chin Club of Canada, Inc., the Southern Alberta Toy Dog Fanciers Society and Vice President of the Canadian Dog Judges Association. She volunteered for the Canadian Kennel Club Appeal and Discipline committees for 20 years. After a childhood filled with animals of all sorts, I was introduced to the purebred dog fancy via hunting and obedience trials. In 1974, I was given an Akita bitch and discovered the conformation show ring. Her son became my first homebred champion, and one of the first Akitas in Canada to earn both his championship and a C.D. Our breeding program went on to produce numerous Canadian and American champions, multiple Best in Specialty winners and Awards of Merit. SunoJo Akitas can be seen in the pedigrees of top winning Akitas around the world.

In 1986, the Shiba Inu joined the SunoJo family and since then have earned multiple Best in Show and Best in Specialty, Groups and Puppy Groups, Specialty wins, Awards of Merit, and top rankings in Canada, the US and around the world. Somehow along the way I became enthralled with the Toys – so much so that Japanese Chin joined the household in 1996.

As well as conformation, I have been involved with obedience and agility, and have served on the executive of all-breed and breed clubs. I started judging in 1996, and the Terrier Group is my final group on the road to All Breed. It is a joy and a privilege to judge, and I greatly appreciate every opportunity to do so.

ATTENTION – ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require CKC registration number **but will require an ERN – Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$62.40 plus 5% GST ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.** A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the **CKC WEBSITE; [HTTP://WWW.CKC.CA](http://www.ckc.ca) / CKC FAX NUMBER (416) 675-6506.**

BORDER CROSSING

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this Certificate and MUST be dated at least 30 days prior to re-enter into the U.S.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$62.40 plus provincial sales tax.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation fee forms are available on the website, [HTTP://WWW.CKC.CA](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

ATTENTION U.S. EXHIBITORS

Current exchange rates favour the American dollar. To take advantage of this please use VISA, MasterCard, American Express or purchase bank drafts or money orders in Canadian dollars. Personal cheques will be accepted – however, **they must be payable for the FULL AMOUNT OF THE ENTRY, payable in U.S. funds.** Discounted cheques will not be honoured. Do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds or "at par".

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of the dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON OVER PAYMENTS OR DUPLICATE ENTRIES



CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular Official Classes at a CKC Confirmation show, all classes must be divided by sex (except Specials Only). Only dogs entered in one of the regular non-regular or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Junior Puppy Class – This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy Class – This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 Month Class – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Bred by Exhibitor Class - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class – This class shall be for all Dogs.

Veterans Class – This class is for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered. This class will be divided into 7 years and under 10 years, 10 years and over.

Specials Only - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

Juvenile Sweepstakes – Classes will be divided by sex as follows; 4 – 6 months, 6 – 9 months, 9 – 12 months, and 12 – 18 months.

Veteran Sweepstakes – Classes will be divided by sex as follows; 7 – 10 years and 10 years and older.

Dam & Progeny – Brood bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner

Sire & Get - Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner

Brace Class - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

Baby Puppy Class – This class shall be for any dog 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

Note: A Listed dog **MAY** be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC

Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information, may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- (a) Registered with the CKC
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number
- (c) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (d) If it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

BORDER CROSSING - A RABIES CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED TO BRING A DOG INTO CANADA, GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE AND IT MUST BE DATED AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY INTO CANADA.

EXHIBITORS, PLEASE NOTE

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE FAMILIAR WITH THE RULES PERTAINING TO THE EVENT IN WHICH THEY ARE COMPETING. THE “DOG SHOW RULES & OBEDIENCE REGULATIONS ARE AVAILABLE FROM: THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB, 200 RONSON DRIVE, SUITE 400, ETOBICOKE, ONTARIO M9W 5Z9.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS

For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs, instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (62.40 plus 5% GST) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.



GENERAL RULES COVERING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.
