Temporary Competition Number (TCN), replacing Listing: TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with “listed dogs”, and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). The current TCN fee is \$12.00 per trial (i.e. per dog, per day).

Event Registration Number: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as “listed”; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled. NOTE: it is less expensive to become a CKC member than to pay this fee each year!

HUNT TEST RULES –

Working Test

Working Spaniel Title -- must complete 2 approved Working Spaniel Tests under at least 2 different pairs of judges.

9.1.1 A working Spaniel must show a desire to hunt in an interesting and enthusiastic manner and demonstrate an ability to retrieve. 9.1.2 Dogs should show no fear of ground and type of cover, respond reasonably well to whistle, verbal and hand commands and maintain a reasonable working distance from their handler. 9.1.3 The working Spaniel must find, flush and retrieve two (2) birds on land. Steadiness is not required. Furthermore, it must retrieve one (1) bird from water by swimming a minimum distance of 20 metres and a maximum of 40 metres. The dog should deliver the birds within a one (1) metre radius from the handler. At the water the dog can be restrained by a leash and sent only at the judge's direction. 26 9.1.4 Dogs which are gun-shy or show no interest or ability to hunt are unacceptable and should be disqualified. 9.1.5 In the event that the dog successfully flushed 2 birds without being sent on a retrieve at the discretion of the judge, a dead bird may be thrown and a shot fired in order to demonstrate the dog's ability to retrieve.

Junior level

(3 legs under 2 different sets of judges is required to obtain title of JH)

The Junior hunting spaniel must show boldness in all types of cover encountered, a definite quartering pattern and an intense desire to hunt within gun range.

Steadiness to wing and shot is not required, however the dog must not chase uncontrollably. At the water the dog must be line steady and wait to be sent at the judge's direction.

All birds must be delivered to hand.

1. Find flush and retrieve 2 birds on land.
2. Retrieve 1 bird from the water swimming a distance of 25-50 metres in a crosswind.

Senior level

(3 legs under 2 different sets of judges is required to obtain title of SH)

A Senior Hunting Spaniel must clearly show all attributes of a Junior hunting Spaniel. At this level the dog must show a very polished quartering pattern that covers the ground in an intense and independent fashion.

All birds must be delivered to hand.

The dog must be steady to wing and shot and be line ready. The dog must flush without encouragement. At the water the dog must be line steady and wait to be sent at the judge's direction.

1. Find and flush 3 birds, retrieving a minimum of 2 birds on land,
2. Retrieve 1 bird from the water swimming a distance of 50-75 metres in a downwind or crosswind.
3. Complete a blind land retrieve a distance of 50 to 75 metres in a downwind or crosswind.
4. Complete a blind water retrieve a distance 30 to 50 metres in a downwind or crosswind.

Master level

(3 legs under 2 different sets of judges is required to obtain title of MH)

A Master Hunting Spaniel must clearly show all attributes of a Senior hunting Spaniel. At this level the dog must be capable of hunting adjacent to another dog and honouring its bracemate when required to do so.

All birds must be delivered to hand.

The dog must show intelligent use of the wind, show the ability to track, be prepared to handle all types of cover and terrain and be under complete control at all times. Interfering with its bracemate and hunting out of control are faults worthy of disqualification.

A minimum of 5 decoys are anchored separately on the water in proximity of the line to be followed by the water retrieve.

A double retrieve has the dog hopped approximately 10 meters from the water's edge. A shot is fired and the first bird is thrown in cover on land 50 to 75 metres. Another shot is fired and the second bird is thrown into the water 35 to 50 metres.

At the judges direction the dog is sent. The handler shall decide which retrieve is to be completed first.

Both birds must be delivered to hand.

1. Find and flush 3 birds, retrieving a minimum of 2 birds on land,
All shot birds must be retrieved.
2. Retrieve 1 bird from the water swimming a distance of 50-75 metres in a downwind or crosswind.
3. Complete a blind land retrieve a distance of 75 to 100 metres in a downwind
4. Complete a blind water retrieve a distance 35 to 50 metres in a downwind.
5. Complete a double retrieve.

Water Test - 8.21.1 The Hunt Test Committee will decide in advance and indicate in the Premium List the method used for the water test. Two methods are acceptable for launching the bird: (a) from a boat as per section 8.21.2 or; (b) from shore or on an island using mechanical device such as a slingshot or catapult as per section

Indignities: “It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 21, section 7*

6.5.1 Any dog withdrawn because of injury or illness, or for a dog that dies, or a bitch that comes into season shall be refunded in full by the event-giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate.

6.5.2 The event-giving club is free to formulate its own policy with reference to refunds for other reasons provided that the terms thereof are clearly stated in the premium list.
