ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. As per Section 6.3.4 of the CKC Herding Rules and regulations

(a)I hereby release the trial-giving club, the owner of the facility, and the owner of the stock from any liability for loss of damage resulting form this trial.

I further agree to pay the full market of \$250.00, for sheep for any livestock death resulting from my dog's actions, whether wilful or accidental, or in the case of injury to any livestock resulting from my dog's actions, I agree to pay all veterinary fees up to the market value of the animal.

Rules:

Perimeter of the Trial:

Only dogs entered in the trials may be within 20 feet of the arena or field fence. Exception: dogs handling stock for these trials.

Section 18.1 of the CKC Herding Rules states:

"The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club, or corporation for any loss, damage, or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC."

Section 15.7 of the CKC Herding Rules states:

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a herding trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as is deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2011 - Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. This is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor who should correspond with the CKC directly. For more information, go to: www.ckc.ca or call 416-675-5511.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All dogs must be at least 6 months of age and registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, or have an ERN, PEN, or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate. CKC Miscellaneous Breeds cannot enter CKC events unless they have a Miscellaneous Number.

CKC RULES: Rule books can be obtained from the CKC by calling the Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040

Every foreign-born and owned dog that is entered in a Canadian Kennel Club event must obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN) within 30 days of that event. An Event Registration Number Application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee. Download the Event Registration Number Application from the online forms section under CKC Services or contact the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

Directions to trial site:

From Okotoks, on Northridge Drive, turn west at the lights at Elizabeth Street(Fast Gas and the Royal Bank will be on the corners). Follow the road, go across the track and continue for approximately 4 km to 354 Avenue W, and turn left. Continue on this road to 48 Street W. Turn right and follow the road to the first place on the left as you reach the top of the hill, and you have arrived.

This is a private home/facility and we need to leave it as we find it. Please clean up after your dogs and do not leave any litter.
