The precincts of these shows will Hall 1 and Hall 2 of the Heritage Park venue. Hall 1 will be used for rings and merchants only; Hall 2 will be used for a grooming area. No persons or dogs shall be allowed in any other part of the facility. Persons not adhering to this rule will be ejected from the show and the venue.

IMPORTANT NOTICE – CRATES ONLY WILL BE PERMITTED AT RINGSIDE DURING THE JUDGING OF YOUR BREED ONLY, THEN MUST BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY. THIS IS ALSO A NON-SMOKING FACILITY.

ADDITIONAL NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following unofficial/non-regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

BRACE CLASS - Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily of the same sex)
(Note: effective January 1, 2006 – identical ownership NO LONGER applies)
SIRE & GET - Shall comprise the Sire and two or more of his Get (Note: Get **MUST** be entered in a Regular class)

DAM & PROGENY - Shall have all the same requirements as the Sire & Get Class (Note: Progeny **MUST** be entered in a Regular class)

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS/VETERANS/RESCUE – Shall be for champions/titleholders in conformation, obedience, tracking, sledding, etc. or dogs over 7 years of age

SLED DOG CLASS (SD) –
SLED DOG EXCELLENT CLASS (SDX) -
SLED DOG UNLIMITED CLASS (SDU) -

Entry requirements for any of the above three Sled Dog Classes are as indicated below:

1. requirements as per CKC Certificate Program. Copy of CKC title certificates must accompany all entries.
2. any dog that does not have a title may be exhibited if proof that said dog has met condition # 1 above is submitted with entry (e.g. completed passport)
3. males and females will compete together in all classes
4. winners of each of these 3 classes will compete together for Best Overall Sled Dog
5. each entry must be entered in a Regular CKC Official class or for Exhibition Only
6. entrants must compete at the "highest eligible level"
7. altered dogs/bitches are eligible

WORKING DOG (WD) –
WORKING DOG EXCELLENT (WDX) –

Entry requirements for any of the above two Working Dog Classes are as indicated below:

1. Copy of title certificates must accompany all entries.
2. males and females will compete together in all classes
3. winners of each of these 2 classes will compete together for Best Overall Working Dog
4. each entry must be entered in a Regular CKC Official class or for Exhibition Only
5. entrants must compete at the "highest eligible level"

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

Conformation Classifications

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **6 months of age and under 9 months of age** on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. **(Champions of any country excluded)**

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

ADDITIONAL REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following additional regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

VETERANS CLASS - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition

PLEASE NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A"/NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A"/OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS**

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES

PRE-NOVICE – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

JUDGES BIOS'

MRS PAULA HARTINGER

Paula Hartinger has been involved in pure bred dogs for over 45 years. Her first breed was Great Danes, but she is best known as an exhibitor and breeder of Standard Schnauzers. She also bred Basset Hounds and Lakeland Terriers, and owned and exhibited West Highland White Terriers and Beagles. As an AKC licensed handler she and her husband Roger exhibited a variety of other breeds.

In 1975 she was granted judges approval by the AKC. Since that time she has judged extensively throughout the USA, Canada, and many other countries. The AKC has approved Roger and Paula for All-Breeds. In some countries they have both been approved to judge all breeds and they have judged a number of FCI shows.

Mrs Hartinger has been secretary of an all breed club, President of two specialty clubs, and show secretary of two all breed clubs.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The Sweepstakes class is open to any SIBERIAN HUSKY from 6 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth. Dogs **MUST** also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty. Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

6 to 9 months Male/Female, 9 to 12 months Male/Female
12 to 18 months Male/Female

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes competition is open to any SIBERIAN HUSKY 7 years of age and over on the day of this event. All dogs **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only.

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS EVENT, BUT MUST BE ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS (Competitive) OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

CLASSES: (divided by sex)

7 years & under 10 years (Males/Females)
11 years & over (Males/Females)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR SWEEPSTAKES

The Bred By Exhibitor Sweepstakes competition shall be for any SIBERIAN HUSKY, owned and handled in the ring by the owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. All dogs **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only.

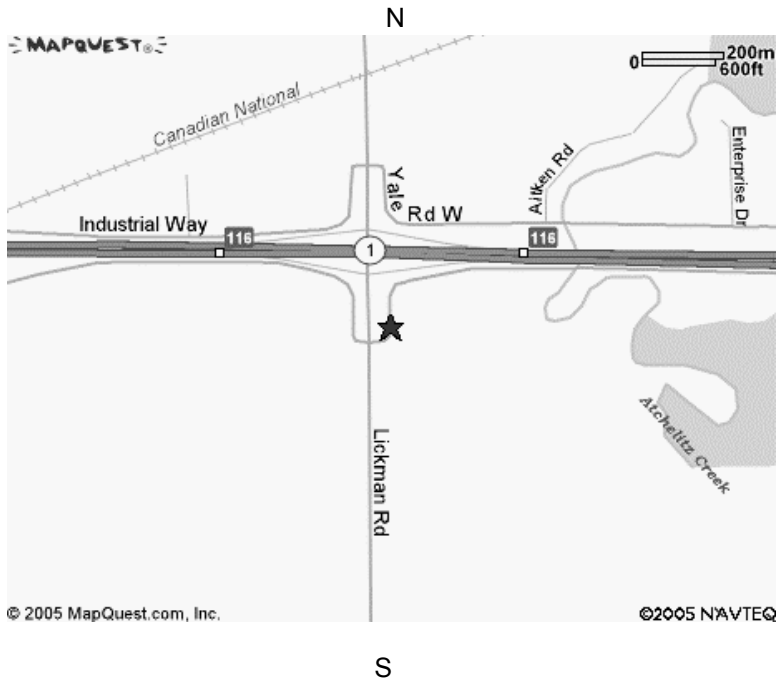

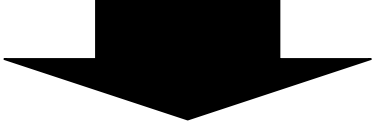

Reserved grooming - again, offered at NO CHARGE! Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Individuals, or groups of individuals with a minimum of 6 dogs may request space. This will be on a first come, first served basis. If you are coming with a large number of dogs, PLEASE request grooming in advance, rather than expecting to be accommodated at the last minute!!

Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first serve and all equipment **MUST BE REMOVED** after Best in Show each night. There will be **NO** exercise pens allowed in this area. Any equipment left in DAY OF SHOW grooming after Best in Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates. Please note: Exercise pens in all areas except Day of Show Grooming (no pens permitted in this area) **may** be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

Specialty clubs will be given a 10' x 15' UPON request. This can be increased depending on the breed and number of entries. Please make your request as soon as possible.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted, may be asked to leave the show.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content.
