## **Exhibitor Information**

#### Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in these trials a dog must be 18 months of age or older and have a CKC Registration number, CCN, MRN, MCN, PEN or a TCN. Females in Season are not allowed to compete and will be refunded their entry and listing fees provided a veterinarian's note stating that the female was in season within 10 days before the start of the trial and is submitted to the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial.

#### Listed Dogs

Dogs without an individual CKC registration number must obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). The TCN allows a dog that is eligible for CKC registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN), to participate in CKC events. Temporary Competition Numbers must be obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid.

While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees when entering events.

#### **Non-Member Participation Fee**

An annual non-member participation fee will apply to any exhibitor who is a Canadian resident and a nonmember of the CKC earning awards/titles. To protect awards/titles earned the non-member will have to pay \$64.00 for each dog being tracked by the CKC or become a CKC member within 30 days or notification. Failure to comply will result in loss of awards/titles.

#### **Foreign Exhibitors**

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars.

## **Other Information**

- Flat **ribbons** will be awarded for qualifying scores and for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> placements. New title rosettes will be available free of charge.
- New CKC rules: Competitors are now allowed to convert their run to FFO on the day. (original entry fee will stand). Competitors are allowed a one-time "Fix and Go" to repeat a completed obstacle on course if a NQ has occurred. The A-frame to be set at 5ft for dogs jumping 16" or less. Handlers are allowed to carry a leash on their person during a run with the proviso that it is fully concealed.
- **Course Familiarization**: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class. There will be a 5-minute break between the end of the walk-through and the first dog on the line.
- Equipment Familiarization will be available for the Novice dogs before the start of the Novice STD class. Dogs will enter ring one at a time. No toys or food allowed.
- **Equipment**: The Table, Teeter, Dog-Walk and A-Frame are all rubberized. Tire is breakaway style. 24" weave poles will be used. Timing is electronic.
- **Points and Distance (PAD)**: PAD is a game of strategy involving distance handling and point accumulation. It is designed to test skill, accuracy, speed, timing, and distance handling. For full rules: <u>Agility-Rules-and-Regulations-Effective-January-en (ckc.ca)</u>
- **Food** trucks and fast food are available off site within a few minutes from the venue. You are responsible for your own food. If there is to be a **lunch break** it will be at the judge's discretion.
- No treats allowed in the ring. Food cannot be within 10 ft of ring.
- Please **pick up** after your dogs or risk excusal from the grounds and do not walk dogs near the kennel.
- No provision for inclement weather. Limited shade available.
- Judging schedule will be emailed after the closing date.
- **Move-ups** will be allowed after the closing date and in between trials.
- Volunteers are necessary to run these events. Family and friends are welcome to help. An online link will be posted on Facebook and sent with judging schedule. We need course builders, scribe, timer, gate and bar setters. Training provided!
