- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, 4. volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)
- 5. No person may approach a judge directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules)
- "Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request 6. those exhibitors doing so to leave the building.
- 7. The building will close one half hour after the completion of daily judging.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows ill be allowed in the building. 8.
- 9. "Puppy for Sale" and "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- 10. The Halifax Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
