John Palmer has been showing dogs since 1975. His first involvement was with Boxers and he started showing Afghan Hounds in 1981. John has been involved with other breeds, such as American Cocker Spaniels, Pugs, English Cocker Spaniels, Miniature Poodles, and he has handled German Shorthair Pointers and Weimaraners with great success.

John has mainly been involved with Greyhounds, since importing the first Greyhounds from America in 1987 from the famous Huzzah Kennels. His Greyhounds have enjoyed enormous success with Champions and BIS Winners around the world.

John also has Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, though rarely shown here they have enjoyed Group and BIS wins in the USA. John has been judging since 1993 with his first group being Hounds, attaining his All-Breeds Status in 2010. He has also been honored to judge the Greyhound club shows in America, Sweden, and Norway. John has officiated at Dog of the Year events in Sydney and most recently Dog of the Year in Auckland and South Africa. He has been fortunate to judge in many countries including Sweden, Norway, Japan, New Zealand, the USA, and Thailand, Malaysia, and China.

I have been involved with sighthounds for over 40 years. My first sighthound was a borzoi that we adopted from the Toronto Humane Society. Shortly after he joined our lives, my wife and I relocated to Alberta. It was here that we met members of the Alberta Lure Coursing Association and became involved in the world of dog sport. My first show prospect was a lovely Scottish Deerhound, Ch Hollywood the Bodhran. Finishing him with a Group First from the classes, as a novice owner-handler was a thrill and a great confidence builder. Bodhran was soon joined by a Borzoi, BIS MultiBIS AmCanCh Swiftess High Sierra of Andare. In the years that followed, my wife and I bred Afghans and, more recently, greyhounds under the Andare prefix. The focus of our small breeding program emphasizes performance and functional hounds with sound temperaments. I have been a CKC All-breed Lure Coursing judge for over ten years and I am currently the Zone 10 Rep on the Lure Coursing Council, CAP Council and Sprinter Council. I am also a licenced NOFCA Hunt Master in open field coursing. Seeing Irish Wolfhounds perform in the field shows a dimension of the breed that one is seldom able to experience. I would like to thank the IWCC Midwestern Branch for the honour of judging their 2023 Specialty Sweepstakes.
