
Serviced and non serviced Camp sites are available at Guelph Lake Conservation Area. To book a site call 519-824-5061

TRACKING FEE

Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect any points and awards earned at any CKC event, a resident non-member can chose to become a CKC member or pay the tracking fee of \$57.60 plus HST for each dog. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

	 Brace Draft Dog: Open to all eligible breeds, registered with the CKC or having an ERN or PEN. In order to compete as a Brace, each dog that makes up a Brace team must have previously earned a CKC Draft Dog Title (DD) title. It is acceptable to enter as a Brace even if one dog has already earned a BDD title. It is acceptable for each dog to have separate owners while competing as one team. Brace Draft Dog Excellent: Open to all eligible breeds, registered with the CKC, or ERN or PEN. In order to compete as a Brace, each dog that makes up a Brace team must have previously earned a CKC Draft Dog Excellent Title.
