ELIGIBILITY: This test is open to all purebred Dachshunds and those recognized Terriers in Group IV and the Miscellaneous Class list originally bred for or developed for use as earthdogs. Small enough to fit into a 9 inch drain, as listed in Appendix A of the CKC Earthdog Test Rules and Regulations. Dogs must be aged 6 months or older.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after the entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The test giving Club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fees.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return email address on their entry forms.

QUARRY: The quarry used in these tests will be 2 adult rats.

FOOD: There will be beverages and snacks available for sale at the tests.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be FAMILIAR with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Earthdog Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel club, 416-675-5511.

CKC REGULATION 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

TEST SITE: Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. There are some trees at the site for added shade. These tests will run rain or shine. The site is a private ranch. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during their test. Please pick up after your dogs – there will be garbage bins at the site.
