#### Attention Foreign Exhibitors

#### NON CKC MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE—Canadian Residents Only

Effective Jan. 1, 2011, the C.K.C. instituted a Non-Member Participation fee for all Canadian Residents who participate in a "CKC event, but are not CKC members. To protect Awards/Titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members, resident in Canada <u>and does not apply to U.S. exhibitors,</u> nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Entries must be received by the Show Secretary prior to closing date. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but must be followed up in writing to **reach the Show Secretary by closing day** (mail, email, fax).
- 2. No entry form will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are complete. Incomplete or unreadable entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fees. Telephone or email entries will not be accepted.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Changes after the closing date are prohibited.
- 4. COKC reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. The Show Superintendent will have full charge of the show. CKC Dog Show rules will be followed.
- 6. Private exercise pens will be allowed only with the permission of the Show Superintendent. Abuse of this privilege will result in removal from the building. Please keep your area clean.
- 7. All dogs must be exercised in the exercise areas provided. Please clean up after your dog. Exhibitors must clean up outside the buildings.
- 8. No dog will be allowed in the show building unless entered in the show. Demonstration dogs are exempt.
- 9. No refund of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete the shows because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the COKC.
- 10. COKC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident or other mishap caused to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators whether the results of accident or otherwise. A dog should not be touched without the permission of the owner or handler.
- 11. The building will be open at 7:00 am.and will close at 11:00 pm. each day of the show. Exhibitors leaving dogs in the building do so at their own risk. There is no night watchman.
- 12. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class or for any awards for the balance of the show.
- 13. Puppies entered in classes other than the Puppy Class are advised to check with the Ring Steward prior to completion of the breed judging to ensure that they are called back to compete for puppy in breed.
- 14. Judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close. Should these not be received within a reasonable period of time, please notify the Show Secretary.
- 15. A dog will be called three (3) times for judging, after which it will be marked absent.
- 16. Dogs should be in the show building 1 hour prior to judging. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside. Handlers are requested to report any absentees and have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere.
- 17. By City Ordinance this is a **NON-SMOKING** building. This rule will be strictly enforced.

It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person, during the running of or in connection with an event abuses or harasses a judge, show official, or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

#### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

**SECTION 1** – A dog awarded *Winners* at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

**SECTION 2** – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded *Winners* shall be as follows.

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. (15.1.2)

The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded *Winners* also places in the **GROUP** as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show**.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and, (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

Best Puppy in Breed Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed is NOT required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

#### MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20** of the **Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show,** by the owner or handler.

**Effective January, 1994:** If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a **LISTED** dog. Listing fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded.** 

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C.
