It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

- No post dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$40.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.
- Entries must be submitted by mail (to the Show Secretary), hand delivered (to 214 Crossley Ave, Truro NS) or via the Entry Line. No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events.

Please Note: Credit Card payments/Fax Entries/eTransfers accepted ONLY through THE ENTRY LINE. The Maritime Toy Dog Club does not accept credit cards for payment.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes: It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and Regulation. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

REFUND INFORMATION ~ COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE DISEASE on the day of the show. To obtain the refund, a letter from a practicing Veterinarian MUST be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-Member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "nonmember of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled. Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Baby Puppy Stud Dog Brood Bitch

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show Junior Puppy A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show Senior Puppy A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show 12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada A dog owned and handled by the breeder Bred by Exhibitor Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months and over, not in competition. NON--REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non--Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy: Dogs 4 months of and under 6 months age on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular class.

Brace: Shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

Stud Dog: Shall be for Stud Dog and two (or more) of his Get only. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch: Shall be for Brood Bitch and two (or more) of her Progeny only. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The brood bitch may be neutered.

Note: All Non--Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark any non--regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship points.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you

4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN) - * EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS ONLY

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

SHOW PHOTOGRAPHER

The official Show Photographer for this event is Oslach Photography. No other photographers may take official photographs on the show/ trial premises.

A copy of the rules pertaining to Conformation Shows or Obedience & Rally-Obedience Trials may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW

The precincts of the Shows and Trials will be the building and its entrances. The Pictou County Kennel Club is hosting this event and MTDC will follow their rules for the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Maritime Toy Dog Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- 2. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises.
- 3. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.

- 4. The Bluenose Curling Ring will be open no earlier than 12:00 p.m. on Friday, for set up.
- 5. NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.
- 6. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT.
- 7. BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
- 8. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- 9. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- 10. Due to the limited amount of space, the Superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the Superintendent in this regard.
- 11. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- 12. Double handling will not be tolerated. The Supt reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing this to leave the building.
- 13. The building will close **1**¹/₂ hours after the completion of daily judging.
- 14. Only dogs entered in the show will be allowed in the building.
- 15. "Puppy For Sale" and "Dog For Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- 16. Maritime Toy Dog Club will not be responsible for any equipment left in the building.
