Born into the world of dogs with a mother who bred Boxers and a father who was a Terrier man and professional handler, Ann started to handle almost as soon as she could walk!! Wanting to have something different for herself she bought a Boston Terrier from England which became her first English Champion when she was just 14 years old. It was not long before she transferred her affections to Boxers and Poodles, and in later years Lhasa Apsos with the occasional Whippet, Beagle, Wire Fox Terrier, Boston, Pug and Shetland Sheepdog just for fun!!! She has subsequently made up 24 English Champions and over 100 Irish Champions. In 1968 she had her first judging appointment under both I.K.C. and E.K.C. Rules. She awarded C.C.'s for the first time in 1977 and became an All Rounder under I.K.C. Rules in 1984. Anne is currently an All Breeds Judge under F.C.I. Rules and has regularly judged in Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Asia, South Africa, South America and 14 European Countries, more than 29 Countries in total, including 3 times at the Stockholm International Winners Show, The European Winners Show Budapest, European Winners Show Dublin, Hobart Royal, Best In Show at Brisbane Royal 2004, Best In Show Helsinki International Winners Show 2005, & two appointments at Crufts. She currently tries to find a balance between judging and breeding dogs, and no longer shows her Boxers but still exhibits Toy Poodles on a regular basis and won the Dog C.C. at Crufts 2008 and World Winner 2008.

JUDGE'S ASSIGNMENT:

Ann (Elizabeth) Ingram-All Regular & Non-Regular classes for all Toy Dogs

Judging will not commence before 8:00 a.m. MDT. However, a later starting time may be announced. Non-regular classes will be judged at the breed and group level. Group judging will follow completion of the Alberta Kennel Club All-Breed judging.

Show precincts shall be within 50 feet of the designated Specialty ring.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is (\$57.60 + 5% GST).
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) ***"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"***

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **\$58.50 + 5% GST**. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

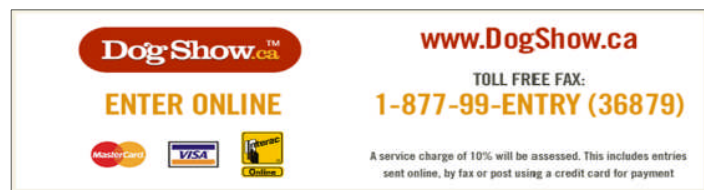
LIMITS OF LIABILITY:

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

REGULAR CLASSES:	
BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 3months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points
JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.
12-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements, The winner of this class will compete for Best of Breed (Veterans do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed / neutered
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes as provided in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	Puppies 3 – 6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or official classes.
NON-REGULAR CLASSES:	
Dogs entered in the following classes must also be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. They may spayed or neutered.	
BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner; must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair.
STUD DOG AND GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his Get. The Stud Dog may be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular Class
BROOD BITCH AND PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. This class shall have the same requirements as for Stud Dog and Get class.

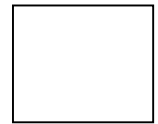
