ONLINE ENTRY: On line entry will be in two stages, you are requested to:

- A. Download then complete the online form available at www.fcrsc2014specialty.com/wcentryform.html and then email the completed form to daeshaken@telus.net.
- B. Return to the page and then use the **"add to cart"** function to pay for your entry through Paypal.

ENTRY INFORMATION: To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept an entry reaching our Test Secretary after the closing time and date. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS: Personal cheques drawn on US accounts will be accepted at par. Discounted cheques will not be honoured. Do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds or "at par".

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON OVERPAYMENTS OR DUPLICATE ENTRIES

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars are completed in full on the entry form. Incomplete entries will be returned. One entry form per dog per day must be received to be eligible. Multiple entries on a single form will not be accepted. Additional entry forms are available on the website at www.fcrsc2014specialty.com.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal disruption. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. An NSF cheque will be subject to a \$20.00 service fee.

Full refunds will be given for dogs withdrawn because of an injury, death and for bitches in season provided written notification is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.

INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ENTERING CANADA

As of June 01, 2009 all US Citizens ages 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document to enter Canada and return to the US.

Please be aware that dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to enter Canada. NOTE Dogs less than three months of age do not require a rabies vaccination.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR FOREIGN DOGS

Effective January 1992, all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. The ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax to the CKC a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with a certified cheque, money order, VISA or Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN, AT THE LATEST, MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: www.ckc.ca.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 01, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member Canadian participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

Knutsford Campground is approximately 5.6 km's on highway 5A from Kamloops City Centre. Signs will be posted from the campground to the test site which is approximately 5 mins down highway 5A and the test site will be a right hand turn off the highway into the landowner's fields.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- A draw for the running order will be held at the home of the test secretary. A running order catalogue will be available at the tests.
- Each dog may only be entered in ONE of the WC, WCI or WCX tests per day.
- A dog must have a CKC WC title before entering the WCI test, and have achieved a WCI title before running the WCX test. A dog may move up from the level entered if it has passed that level since registering. Please contact the test secretary early in the morning of the test (earlier if possible) to fill out the necessary form and pay the additional \$5.00 entry fee if the move up is from WC to WCI.
- No training will be allowed on the test grounds.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to run.
- The WC test and the WCI/X test will run concurrently. If you have multiple dogs entered, please inform the marshals; the running order will be adjusted to accommodate you.
- Meet at 8:00 am, dogs to line 8:30 am

- It will be at the WCI/X judges' discretion whether they will run the WC Intermediate dogs first or the WC Excellent dogs first.
- Check in with your marshal at the test site on arrival.
- Ducks will be used for land and water tests.
- All handlers must wear dark or camouflage clothing.
- All qualifying dogs will be awarded a standard CKC rosette and a prize.
- There will be no concession on site and there are no eating establishments close by, please bring your lunch and enough water for you and your dogs.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The WC Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- There is very little shade available on this property so please be prepared to provide relief from the sun for yourself and your dogs.
- Please be considerate to the land owners who have allowed us the use of this property and do not leave any garbage behind.
