HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

DOG SHOW RULES

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 6 - Section 6.3.3 of the Dog Show Rules states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

Entries for all Regular/Non-regular/Unofficial/ Sexually Altered . Each dog entered in one (or more) of the Non-regular/Unofficial classes <u>MUST</u> be entered in one of the Regular classes or "Specials Only".

TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as

"listed", and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

TCNs can be obtained:

Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);

By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or

By contacting the Shows and Trials Division Toll Free at 1-855-364-7252.

All fees include G.S.T. and are in Canadian Funds.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 13, Section 13 of the Dog Show Rules has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **E**vent **R**egistration **N**umber (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$53.50 per dog. For further information contact:

ENTRY INFORMATION

No Entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the Entry Form are completed in full.

Handlers or Agents please note the full name and address of all owners MUST BE FILLED IN.

Incomplete Entries Will Be Returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by Entry Fees.

Telephone and Telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

Alterations, Substitutions or Cancellations of any Entry after the Closing Date is prohibited, except moving Class Dogs to Specials. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. ENTRIES CLOSE 9:00 PM TUESDAY August 25, 2022 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.

Identification Cards and Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

<u>SECTION 1:</u> A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be DOGS COMPETING:

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above:

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

The following Official Classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY ~ Dogs 6 months but under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY - Dogs 9 months but under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTHS - Dogs 12 months but under 18 months on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED - Dogs born in Canada. Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - Dogs owned/handled in the ring by the breeder. Handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog.

OPEN - All dogs

SPECIALS ONLY - For Canadian Champions only. Must have a CKC registration number or ERN. Listed dogs cannot enter the Specials Class.

VETERANS - Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. (Specialty shows only) These dogs to compete for regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best Of Breed. Spayed/Neutered dogs may compete.

EXHIBITION ONLY - For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

BEST PUPPY IN BREED & BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SHOW WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS SHOW

SEXUALLY ALTERED DOGS:

All rules and regulations in the CKC Dog Show Rules shall apply except for those which disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition. Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding awards for lack of merit is encouraged. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging.

These classes will be judged after the judging of the Best Of Breed in the Regular classes and before the non-regular/unofficial judging.

OFFICIAL CLASSES: One class for Males, One class for Females. Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Of Breed Altered and Best Of Opposite Sex Altered will be offered at this show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS- Dogs 4 months but under 6 months on the day of the show. (divided by sex)

STUD DOG - Stud dog and 2 (or more) of his get. Class will be judged on the merits of the get.

BROOD BITCH - Brood bitch and 2 (or more) of her progeny. Class will be judged on the merits of the progeny.

BRACE - A Brace should be judged as an identical pair - same color, size, gait and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person and 1 LEAD.

TEAM -. A Team should be judged on same merits as the brace class (see above description).

The following unofficial classes will take place at the competition of the Specialty Show; that is, after the judging of Best of Breed, Altered Classes and Non-Regular Classes.

GAIT - Movement is the prime purpose for this class. It is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show. The judge shall withhold this trophy when he/she feels that no hound entered in this class has the desired degree of excellence and efficiency of movement to deserve the award.

HEAD - To emphasize the importance of a typical head as a distinguishing feature of the Breed. It is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show.

HINDQUARTERS - This class is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show. The winner will be the one that exhibits the preferred hindquarter assembly to the judge on the day of the show.

<u>NOTE</u>: As per CKC rules, a spayed/neutered dog may be entered in the Veterans class and in any of the non-regular or unofficial classes. Dogs entered in the non-regular classes must also be entered in either a Regular, Veteran, Sexually Altered classes or Exhibition Only.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 26.7)

TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as "listed", and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently

registered or has an ERN.

TCNs can be obtained:

Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);

By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or

From Montréal, take any bridge to south shore, then highway 15 south, direction Laprairie and New-York state; Exit 6, turn left on route 202, direction Lacolle, turn right on rang Saint-André. Rang Saint-André is the first one on your right.

Follow the indications for "Parc Régional Saint-Bernard".

From Western provinces, from autoroutes 20 (401) or 40 (417), take highway 30 (exit Sorel-Tracy) and 15 south direction USA, exit 6, 202 to Lacolle and first road on your right, follow indication to the Park.
