- **Cheques will not be accepted the Friday of the tests**
- A \$9.60 listing fee must accompany any entry form for dogs without an individual C.K.C. registration or ERN
- Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date, for reasons other than stated in the C.K.C. Working Certificate rule book, will not have their entry fees refunded
- All fees to be in Canadian funds, no exchange will be given on U.S. funds

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **Entries:** Entries must be completely filled out and signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms or where hand-writing is not clearly legible. No phone, faxed, emailed, late or day of entries will be accepted. A separate entry for EACH dog in EACH test is required on an official CKC entry form. ERNs (Event Registration Numbers) for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC.
- **All entry confirmations will be sent by email.**
- **Listing Fee:** A \$9.60 (including HST) listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form.
- **Canadian Resident Non-CKC Member:** Important: The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact CKC Head Office.
- **Rules:** Working Certificate Test Rules and Regulations Books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, 100 – 89 Skyway Ave., Etobicoke, ON M9W 6R4 or downloaded from [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca)
- **Awards:** Official CKC Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs at the end of the test.
- **Catalogues:** Catalogues and maps of test sites will be available at Headquarters.
- **Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after September 3, 2017. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, no refund of entry will be made. Bitches in season are NOT eligible for entry and are not allowed on the test grounds. Bitches may be subject to vetting. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, illness or death shall be refunded in full if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. All refunds must be requested in writing and once the catalogue has been printed, will be less CKC event fees and listing fees if applicable.
- **Running Order:** Running order will be drawn at the home of the Test Secretary. Males and females will be run in the order of the draw or at the discretion of the Marshall. The running order will be posted on the Dog Ranch Inc. Website ([www.dogranchinc.ca](http://www.dogranchinc.ca))
- **Start Times:** Start times will be adhered to as strictly as possible and handlers are asked to be at their stake and checked in with their Marshall a minimum of 15 minutes prior to start time regardless of running order.
- **Clothing:** All handlers and spectators shall wear hunting attire, dark or camouflage clothing.
- **Birds:** Game birds will be used.
- **Grounds:** Bring adequate shade, sunscreen, water and cover for hot or rainy weather for both you and your dog(s). Be prepared and carry a first aid kit. YOU MUST pick up after your dog and airing is only allowed in areas designated by WC Test Headquarters and Test Marshalls. Please respect the landowners that have so graciously allowed us on their land by obeying all signs, removing all garbage and debris. Close all gates behind you and park ONLY in designated areas.
- **Collars:** "Electronic collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by a dog on the grounds of a WC Test at any time during the event with the exception of those collars designed to curb barking which may be worn by a dog while kennelled.
- **Meals:** There will be no food available for purchase at the headquarters. Food is available in the Spencerville area (The Pantry, Spencer City Café, Jade Palace, Drummonds).

- **Indignities to Judges, Club Officials, Volunteers or Participants:** CKC WC Test Rule Section 14.7 – “It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC and infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.”
- **Disclaimer:** Competitors agree to hold the organization, its members, officers, and directors, the Canadian Kennel Club, and its officers and directors, sponsors of the event, owners of the premises upon which the event is held, and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while on the premises or grounds of the tests, and competitors personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury be caused, or allege to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. Competitors assume the sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefore, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death, or damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties, their employees or agent, or any other person. The personal information provided as a competitor will be used to administer these events in accordance with the CKC rules governing the events. By signing your entry form, you consent to the information described herein.

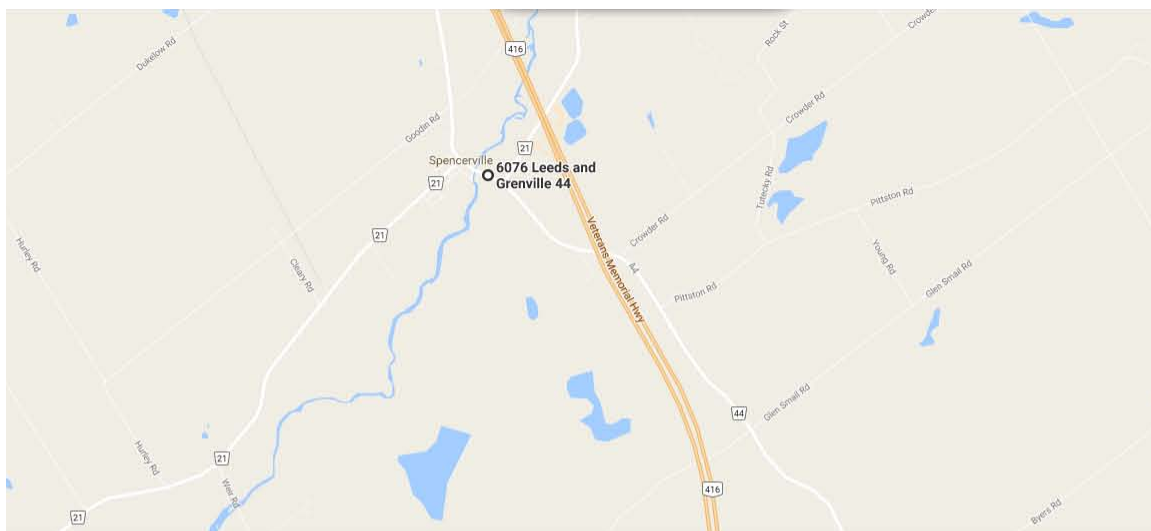
## CHECK-IN:

## TRAVELLING TO HEADQUARTERS AT SPENCERVILLE:

From Hwy # 401 Eastbound: Take Exit 721A or Westbound: Take Exit 721B (look for signs for 416 to Kemptville). Continue onto Hwy #416 north. Drive approximately 12 km to exit 12 to Spencerville/CR21. Turn left onto CR21 and drive about 1 km to CR44. Turn right and drive about 200 m. The test headquarters at 6076 County Road 44 is on the left.
