Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date. It is recommended that you phone after you fax your entry to ensure that it was received and readable. All NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35.00 service fee.

^{*}Any dog entered in an unofficial class must also be entered in an official class or Exhibition Only. **A Listing Fee of \$8.95 must be paid for any dog not having a CKC individual registration number or ERN.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted,

however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

Border Crossing

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned, and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at 416-675-5511 (phone) or 416-675-6506 (fax).

Conformation Classes

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY- dogs 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY- dogs 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show.

12 TO 15 MONTHS- dogs 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 TO 18 MONTHS- dogs 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED- dogs born in Canada.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR- dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS- all dogs. Class divided by colour: Black and Tan, Blenheim, Ruby, Tri-Colour.

VETERAN- dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Class divided by age. The winner of each class will compete for Best of Breed.

7 TO 9 YEARS

9 TO 11 YEARS

11 YEARS AND OLDER

SPECIALS ONLY- A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible, it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a listed dog in this class is NOT allowed.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

BABY PUPPY- 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

STUD DOG & GET- shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY- This class shall have the same requirements as Stud Dog & Get.

BRACE- This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair- same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

ALTERED- This class shall be for neutered or spayed dogs over 6 months of age.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

Puppy and Juvenile Sweepstakes

Classes divided by sex: 6 to 9 months, 9 to 12 months, 12 to 15 months, 15 to 18 months. Entrants must be entered in a regular class. The Club will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

First in each class 5% of total entry fee & rosette

Second, Third & Fourth in each class rosette

Best in Sweepstakes 20% of total fee & rosette Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes 15% of total fee & rosette

Veteran Sweepstakes

Classes divided by sex: 7 to 9 years, 9 to 11 years, 11 years and older. Entrants must be entered in a regular class or Exhibition Only. The Club will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

First in each class 5% of total entry fee & rosette

Second, Third & Fourth in each class rosette

Best Veteran in Sweepstakes 25% of total fee & rosette Best Runner Up in Sweepstakes 20% of total fee & rosette

Junior Handling

Registration will be at the show secretary's table. Complete entries only. Prize and rosette offered for Best Overall and for each placement.

Classes in Junior Conformation Handling competition shall be divided by age as follows:

PEE WEE CLASS-This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

JUNIOR NOVICE CLASS- This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

JUNIOR OPEN CLASS-This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS- This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS- This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level. SENIOR NOVICE CLASS- This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the

date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

SENIOR OPEN CLASS- This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level

Method of moving between classes shall be as follows: If a handler achieves 6 first place wins with competition, he must move to the Open Class within his age group. Points are to be carried forward from one level to the next.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 3 or more Points Allocated* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN).

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship. All required points are to be earned at the breed level. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include one Best of Breed and a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed Winner and the number of similar sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013. Points earned toward the Grand Champion title are to be recorded by the owner/handler on the form obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. Once the owner/handler believes that their exhibit has attained the requirements for the Grand Champion title, the form may be submitted to the Canadian Kennel Club for verification and awarding of the title.

<u>Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)</u> The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
- 2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
- 3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
- 4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING THE DOG.
- 5. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 6. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS.
- 7. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
- 8. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
- 9. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online, by fax or post using a credit card or interac for payment.
