JIM BRICKNELL

I purchased my first purebred dog in 1971, a Newfoundland. In 1973 I registered my kennel name "Bayside" and Bred my first litter in 1975. I have only bred Newfoundlands but have owned and or exhibited Whippets, Cairns, English Bulldogs, Australian Terriers, Yorkshire Terrier and St. Bernards.



My wife Diane and I have bred MBIS Newfoundlands, National Speciality winners, and many Stud Dog, Brood Bitch award winners. Also CKC Award winning Newfoundlands.

I have judged Newfoundland National Specialties in Canada, United States, Denmark, Italy, England and under contract to judge Newfoundland Specialties in Norway and Sweden in 2011, for a total of 14 Newfoundland Specialties. I have also Judged the Mastiff Club of Canada Speciality, St. Bernard Specialty and Great Pyrenees Specialty.

I am licensed for Group 3 and half of Group 7, this will be my fourth permit for all of Group 7.

I am a life Member of the CKC and the Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada of which I am the current President and Chairman of the Judges Education Committee. I am a Member of the Newfoundland Club Of America and on the NCA Judges Education Committee. 30

JOCELYNE GAGNE

My involvement with and love of Irish Wolfhounds began in 1978 and I bred my first litter, under the Starkeeper prefix in 1980. Since then I have bred over 85 Irish Wolfhounds that became champions, obedience titlists, lure coursing and racing champions in Canada and the USA. I have bred and handled my hounds to numerous Best In Show and Best in Specialty wins, including both the prestigious American and Canadian National Irish Wolfhound specialties. I consider one of my major accomplishments



to be that amongst the major specialty wins that Starkeeper hounds have earned, 6 of these were achieved by veterans.

For over twenty years I have judged Lure Field Trials and have officiated in this sport in Canada, the United States and Italy.

As a conformation judge I am approved by the Canadian Kennel Club for all breeds in the Hound, Terrier and Toy Groups and am licensed to judge Best in Show. I am approved by the Kennel Club (England) to judge Irish Wolfhounds.

My conformation judging invitations have included shows across Canada, the United States, Northern Ireland, United Kingdom, Italy, Luxembourg, Australia and New Zealand. These assignments have included both all breed shows and various specialties and supported entries, including most of the hound breeds, Terriers, Poodles, Chihuahuas and most recently a record entry of Norbottenspets. I have judged numerous Irish Wolfhound and hound specialties both in North America and abroad.

JUAN ALBERTO GRILLO

Since 1990 Juan has been working at The Clermont School as the financial manager, sharing with his own passengers transportation company and agriculture activities.

When he was two months old his parents gave him a Boxer who lived with him until he was nine years old. After that he got a Great Dane and Collie shepherd. Competing in dog shows the results were very good, obtaining the first championships.



On December 1990, he got married to Aida Rivera Franco, who also shares the hobby of dogs. They started the breeding of Fila Brasileiro,

Napolitan Mastiff, winning during two years the top breed, with more

than ten championships. After that, they imported Shar Pei and Dogo de Bourdeux, the first dogs of these breeds in Colombia, generating interest and getting many championships. He has had the opportunity of handling and breeding Beagle, Bull Terrier, Siberian Husky and Shiba Inu.

JUAN ALBERTO GRILLO (cont'd)

Actually they show and breed Dachshunds, Chinese Cresteds, Pugs and Pomeranians, winning with one Pom the Best All Around Dog Breed of the year, awarded in Colombia in 2002. In 1997, they imported Chinese Cresteds, winning more than 20 international championships and the first Best in Show in Latin America for this breed.

As handler and breeder he has always had the best breeds from the ones he chooses and having more than 100 international championships, showing just his own dogs.

Since 1997 he has been the president of the Corporacion Club Canino de Sabana, and treasurer and member of the board of the Asociacion Club Canino Colombiano since 2002. Currently he is the President of the judges committee in Colombia, and the representative and member for the FCI judges commission since 2007. He has judged in Colombia, Perú, Brasil, Argentina, Ecuador, Costa Rica, México, United States and Canada.

KIM RAMEY-LEBLANC

I purchased my first dog, a Siberian Husky male in 1973. He, fortunately for us, was of good enough quality to become our first champion and sired our first litter. That was the beginning of Snowmist Siberians. My timing could not have been better for getting involved in this breed as many of the most famous kennels and their founders were still in existence. My mom and I had a short-lived trial with Alaskan Malamutes and decided they were not for us. But the adventure with other breeds continued and we enjoyed a Newfoundland and a few Salukis. During this time



I handled many different breeds. In 1980 my husband brought American Foxhounds into the picture, we still have them today along with the Siberians.

I am still actively showing and breeding on a small scale. Our kennel (Snowmist Siberians) has been highly successful in Canada and around the world. My husband and I competed in sled dog races winning our fair share of awards up until the fall of 1996 when family and business commitments forced us to retire. While racing, we actively participated in the Canadian Kennel Club's Sled Dog Certificate Program earning over 90 titles. Our dogs have numbered in the top for our breed on many occasions including Top Siberian 1986 & 1987 with BlS, BISS Am/Can Ch. Snowmist's Mai Tai, Top Siberian 1994 BIS Ch. Kakoma's Better Than Average and topped the charts again in 2001 with BIS Ch. Snowmist's Eternal Flame. In 2008 Davik's Snowmist Ice Fox in a few short months of shows made it to #4 Siberian Husky Club of Canada awarded our lead dog Northstar's Snowmist Birch C.D., S.D.U. the Ward Young Trophy for successfully competing in sled dog racing, showing and obedience within one club year. This was the first time any dog had won this award in back to back years.

I am a graduate of the canine course "Dogs, A Hobby or Profession" created by the late Casey Gardiner. Included in this educational program was a course on structure that taught structure based on a measuring process. I have conducted all breed measuring clinics as well as seminars on this topic. Today I am a licensed All Breed Canadian Kennel Club judge. I began my judging career officially in 1994. Since that time I have had the honour of judging in my own country (Canada), Australia, Belgium, England, France, Finland at the Winner 2000 Show, Hong Kong, Ireland, Italy, Japan, South Korea, Lithuania, New Zealand, Spain, and the United States of America. Specialties I've had the pleasure of judging include the Rocky Mountain Siberian Husky Club, the Belgian Siberian Husky Club (twice), Saint Bernard Club of Ontario, Great Pyrenees Club of Central Ontario, Alaskan Malamute Club of NSW Inc., The Siberian Husky Club of NSW Inc., the first ever back to back Siberian Husky Club of Great Britain Championship shows, the National Specialty for Nordic Breeds (Spain), the Briard Club of America, Inc. (regional), the Nordic Breed Club of Lithuania and the 8e Reunion Nationale d'Elevage du Siberian Husky France as well as several others.

I have been an active member for many years of the all breed club, Barrie Kennel & Obedience Club Inc. I have held such positions as President, Show Chair Person, and Judges Selection Committee. Currently I hold the position of President. I served as the Canadian Kennel Club Director for Zone 4 - Ontario North from 2004 through 2008. My duties have included; Chair of the Canadian Kennel Club Junior Kennel Club Council, past Chair of the Club Relations Committee, member of the Breed Specific Legislation Committee, and Judge's Hospitality and Transportation Chair for the Purina National – CKC Charity Event.

WALTER PINSKER

Mr. Walter Pinsker was born in Vienna, Austria in 1939 and is currently living in Canada since 1956. He is fluent in English and German and speaks a little Spanish. He took early retirement in 1997 to be able to pursue his worldwide Travels. He and his wife Monika started their "Mephisto" Boxer Kennel in 1968 and under that prefix have been extremely successful worldwide. They have produced well over 100 Champions who in turn have been awarded Best In Show awards over 150 times among them. They have produced the Number One Boxer in Canada many times. They were the breeders of the Number 1 All



Breed Dog in Canada as well as the No.1 All Breed Dog in Japan. They have owned, have bred and exhibited Whippets, Smooth Fox Terriers, Shiba Inus and Akitas. Mr. Pinsker started to judge in 1978 and is licensed to judge All Breeds since 1990.

Mr. Pinsker has officiated as a judge in the United States, Canada, Mexico, South Africa, Argentina, Brazil, Peru, Columbia, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Philippines, Japan, Venezuela, Chile, Costa Rica, Sweden, Germany, Australia, New Zealand and Norway, as well as Tasmania, Malaysia, Singapore, Tschech. Republic, China and Ecuador.

He has had the honor to be asked to judge Specialties in the following breeds: Boxers, (such as: ABC Regional, Australian National, Japan, Norway National, Hong Kong, Brazil, Mexico, Costa Rica, South Africa and the Philippines, as well as numerous ones in the United States) Akitas, Whippets, Gordon Setters, American Cocker Spaniels, Borzois, All Dachshunds, Norwegian Elkhounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Bernese Mountain Dogs, Doberman Pinschers, Great Danes, Great Pyrenees, Newfoundland, Rottweilers, Samoyeds, St. Bernards, Airedale Terriers, Welsh Terriers, the entire Toy Group Specialties, the entire Non Sporting Group Specialties, Bouviers des Flandres, German Shepherd Dogs, Bullmastiffs, Samoyeds, Shiba Inu, Siberian Huskies, Min. & Giant Schnauzer, Bulldog and Yorkshire Terriers.

I have been involved with dogs all of my life, and when I didn't have a dog of my own, I would "borrow" other people's dogs. I started with the family dog, a Boston Terrier, when I was a toddler. As I grew older and our family didn't actively own a dog I would take in strays and hide them until their owners came knocking on the door.



When my family moved to Vancouver Island I was able to indulge my passion for dogs when I started an apprenticeship as a Kennel Manager with Jean Westwood (Wisherwood Kennels). My first "show" dog was a

Rough Collie, soon followed by an Afghan Hound, and so the true saga begins.

I bred and showed Afghan Hounds under the Bala Hissar prefix for 30 years. During that time I had close involvement (through family members) with the following breeds: Miniature Pinchers, Brussels Griffons and all varieties of Dachshunds (my sister Gerri, Caress Kennels); Toy and Miniature Poodles and Chihuahuas (my mother), Dobermans, French Bulldogs and Greyhounds (my Partner, Carla Thompson, Seeonee Kennels). Finally, the circle has become complete and I now have two Boston Terriers whom I am actively showing, loving and obsessing over.

In the 1990's I began the "Judging" process and since receiving All-Breed status I have traveled extensively judging All Breed Shows throughout Canada, the United States, Australia, New Zealand, and Argentina.

I have been honoured to judge National Specialties for Bull Mastiffs, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Beagles and Stafforshire Terriers in Australia, the Boxer Specialty in New Jersey in the U.S and most recently the Group 6 Specialty in British Columbia.
