### **GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that:

- (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed

**ENTRY LIMIT:** Entries will be limited to 40 runs per test.

Post (day of) test entries will NOT be accepted at this test. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

**BITCHES IN SEASON:** Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

**BORDER CROSSING:** A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

**TEST SITE:** Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test. **Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site.** Remember that this is a public park used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog.

The test site is not fenced. No dogs are allowed near the washrooms or food area. Dogs may be created in the pavilion.

Bathroom facilities and food are available on site.

**REGULATIONS:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Sprinter Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Tel: 1-800-250-8040.

**CKC Regulation:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
