- 6) No smoking anywhere on the trial site. You may smoke in your car or in the fields.
- 7) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.

***Travel Times (approx):***

London, via 401 to 403 to Highway 24 South: 45 minutes  
Burlington, via QEW to 403 to Highway 24 South: 45 minutes  
Kitchener, via Cambridge and Paris to Highway 24 South: 45 minutes

From Highway 403, take exit 27 at Highway 24 South/Rest Acres Road  
Travel south on Highway 24, passing through traffic lights at Colborne Street and again at Scotland.  
Continue south on 24 until you reach Windham Road 6, then turn right.

We are the second house on the left. About 15 minutes from Highway 403.
