Temporary Competition Number TCN

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO: FC Specialty 2020

There will be no refunds on overpayments or duplicate entries. Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques will be assessed a \$20.00 service charge. Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. You may send a cheque in US funds, however, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. THANK YOU.

SAME DAY ENTRIES

A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, ERN, MCN or CCN number may enter on the same day of the trial, however, a new entry form must be completed by the owner or handler and submitted to the trial secretary, along with the appropriate fee (\$35.00 per dog, per trial) 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of that particular trial for which the dog is being entered, schedule permitting. The trial secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC

LIMITED ENTRY OBEDIENCE

When Judges' assignments have reached 7 hours, entries will close automatically, even if the official closing date has not arrived. CKC Rule 4.3.3.: The 7 hours is based on the formula of 9 Pre-Novice entries, 8 Novice entries, 7 Open entries, 6 Utility entries per hour and 20 dogs per hour for Rally. When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries may be assigned a position (by class) on the reserve list. The person making the entry shall be notified of his/her position on the list. In the event the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to, and including, the day of the trial.

CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following CKC classes, divided by sex will be provided:

Junior Puppy - for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age

Senior Puppy - for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age

12-18 Months - for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age

Canadian Bred - for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded

Bred by Exhibitor - for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards

Open - for all dogs

Veteran 7 to 9 - for dogs 7 years of age but under 9 years of age

Veteran 9 to 11 - for dogs 9 years of age but under 11 years of age

Veteran 11 plus - for dogs 11 years or older

NOTE: Veteran class dogs do not compete for Winners but shall compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in veteran classes may be spayed or neutered.

Field Class- Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title in CKC Working Certificate or Hunt Test or placement in a CKC field trial. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging and do not compete for Winners. The winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only - for dogs that are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained Championship status. **The entry of a dog with a "TCN" is not allowed.**

One Award of Merit will be offered for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level.

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

Sexually Altered Classes - Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age that have been spayed or neutered. Points MAY NOT be carried from regular competition judging to the Altered Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after the specialty Best of Breed.

Two classes will be offered: **Altered Male and Altered Female.** Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes; the first-place winner from each class will be declared Winners, and the second-place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

Baby Puppy - for dogs 3 months of age but under 6 months of age

Brace - Two dogs of the same breed, not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead.

Stud Dog & Get - Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny - Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Exhibition Only - dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-regular classes (Dogs must also be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only).



OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Pre-Novice - for all dogs over 6 months of age. Not eligible for HIT Competition.

Novice A - for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class.

Novice B - dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. More than one dog may be entered in this class.

Novice C - for dogs who have completed a CKC CD title. Not eligible for HIT competition.

Novice Intermediate - for dogs who have earned a CD title in Canada. Not eligible for HIT Competition.

Open HA and Open 18A - for dogs that have completed a CKC CD title but have not earned the title of CDX (Companion Dog Excellent). Must be handled by owner or immediate family member. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person that has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle a dog in these classes.

Open HB and Open 18B - for dogs that have completed a CKC CD title. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. More than one dog may be entered in this class by any one person or owner.

Utility A - for dogs who have earned a CKC CDX title but not a CKC UD. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class. That person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class.

Utility B - for dogs who have earned a CKC CDX title or UD in Canada Exhibition Only - for dogs 6 months & over, not in competition. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. More than one dog may be entered in this class.

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Brace - is open to any two Flat-coated Retrievers and of either sex, that have earned the title of CD or higher in Canada. The same person need not own both dogs. The exercises shall be performed as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must be entered in any regular class or for Exhibition Only

Veteran Class - for any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veteran Class must be entered in any regular class or for Exhibition Only.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A - For dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the owner or immediate family member. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class.

Novice B - For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.

Intermediate - For dogs that have earned a RN title. The Rally Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Rally Advanced classes.

Advanced A - For dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD and is handled by the owner or immediate family member. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class.

Advanced B - For any dog that has earned the RA title or any handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title. **Excellent A** - for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD and is handled by the owner or immediate family member. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class.

Excellent B - For any dog that has earned the RA title or any handler that has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title. **Masters** – This class will be for dogs that have earned RE title. A dog completing the RM title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person can enter more than one dog in this class.



MOVING UP

A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, ERN, MCN or CCN number and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules, may be moved to the next level of competition. When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the class for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting. The Trial Secretary shall amend the Judge's Book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms
All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
A Bitch in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally Trials.

SWEEPSTAKES

Juvenile Sweepstake entrants must be entered in the Regular classes.

Veteran & Gundog Sweepstake entrants must be entered in a Regular class, an Altered class or For Exhibition Only.

Spayed and neutered veterans and gundog entrants may compete.

Juvenile Sweepstakes: Classes will be divided by sex & age as follows:

6 to 9 months 9 to 12 months 12 to 18 months

Veteran Sweepstakes: Classes will be divided by sex & age as follows:

7 to 9 years 9 to 11 years 11 plus years and over

Gun Dog Sweepstakes: Classes will be divided by sex and accomplishment as follows:

Working Retriever has a CKC WC, WCI or JH title

Field Retriever has a CKC WCX, one SH leg, SH or MH title or a CKC sanctioned field trial placement. Best working retriever and field retriever in each sex will compete for Best Gundog in Sweeps

JUVENILE, VETERAN & GUNDOG SWEEPSTAKE AWARDS

Monies collected FOR JUST JUVENILE and then those collected FOR JUST VETERAN, & those collected FOR JUST GUNDOG will be awarded within THAT SWEEPSTAKE CATEGORY in the following manner:

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES Rosette & 15% of total fees collected
BEST OF OPPOSITE Rosette & 10% of total fees collected
FIRST IN EACH CLASS Rosette & 8% of total fees collected
SECOND – FOURTH Rosette offered for each class
25% retained by club to defray costs

The winner from each of the above classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in each category—Juvenile, Veteran & Gundog. A trophy will be offered for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex. A trophy will accompany the rosettes being offered for 1st to 4th place in each class.

Be proud of your own dog – show it off in Sweepstakes! The FCRSC Juvenile, Veteran & Gundog Sweepstake events provide a great opportunity for owners and breeders to showcase the potential of their young dogs, the longevity and soundness of their veteran dogs and the sound structure of their gundogs. The FCRSC strongly encourages all owners to handle their own puppies, veterans, gundogs in sweepstakes, whenever possible. If you are physically unable to show your own dog on the move, you may bring a "runner" into the ring to move the dog for you.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Registration will take place at the Show Secretary's table up to 1 hour prior to the event Competition for juniors between the ages of 7 and up to 18 years of age by Dec. 31, 2019. Dogs handled by the juniors must be entered in a Class or For Exhibition Only (conformation or obedience) at the FCRSC show or trial. Dogs need not be owned by the junior. Please refer to the CKC Rule Book Junior Handling Rules and Regulations for details of classes.

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners. In counting the eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Additional Championship points may be attainable at the group level. See the CKC dog Show Rules for Details.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

As of June 1, 2009, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document to enter and return to the USA.

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR FOREIGN DOGS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN, AT THE LATEST, MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS: SELF-SERVE ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR LISTED DOGS

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. A judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at this event must not be subjected to indignities. The Conformation/Obedience Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Some additional thoughts

Kakabeka Falls is located near the show and field sites and has amenities for the participants. A grocery, drug store, gas, coffee, restaurants are located there. The provincial park, just to the west of town, has a beautiful waterfall for viewing and lots of trails for walking.

Bathing will be available at the site, but due to electrical limitations, bathing may have to be restricted to after show hours depending on the show entry. If using a generator to dry your dog, the bath should be accessible throughout the weekend. If the circuits are triggered, everyone is inconvenienced, so bathing will be monitored.

Grace's Closet is a clothing exchange for show outfits. **All juniors shop for free,** other exhibitors pay a minimal charge which supports our local junior handling program. Please stop by.

Caterer for lunches
