U.S. exhibitors may pay by personal cheques payable in U.S. funds, for the full amount of the entry. Cheques in U.S. funds will be accepted at par and may not be discounted.

• A \$40 NSF charge will be applied on all returned cheques. Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry.

- 1. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER, WHETHER OR NOT MEMBERS OF ASCA, WILL ABIDE BY THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE AUSTRALIAN SHEPHERD CLUB OF AMERICA AND ANY OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS APPEARING IN THE PREMIUM LIST FOR THIS EVENT.
- 2. EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS CERTIFY THAT THE ENTERED DOG IS NOT A HAZARD TO PERSONS, DOGS, OR PROPERTY.
- 3. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER ACKNOWLEDGE ALL HAZARDS PRESENTED BY THE EVENT AND THE EVENT PREMISES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE CONDITION OF THE FLOORS, STAIRWAYS, HALLS, LIGHTING, SECURITY MEASURES (OR LACK THEREOF), ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES, SHOW RINGS, PARKING AREAS AND THE PRESENCE OF UNFAMILIAR ANIMALS AND PEOPLE. EXHIBITOR AND OWNER ASSUME THE RISK OF ANY HARM ARISING FROM THESE.
- EXHIBITOR AND OWNER RELEASE ASCA AND WILL DEFEND ASCA AND HOLD IT HARMLESS FROM ALL PRESENT AND FUTURE LOSS, INJURY, DAMAGE, CLAIMS, DEMANDS AND LIABILITIES INVOLVING THE ENTERED DOG, THE EVENT, OR THE EVENT PREMISES.
 - a. FOR EXAMPLE, SHOULD THE ENTERED DOG INJURE STOCK, THE OWNER WILL PAY FOR VETERINARIAN SERVICES. IF THE INJURY IS SEVERE, OWNER WILL PAY THE MARKET VALUE OF THE STOCK.
