<u>Pre-Novice</u> – Deleted: Circle Left and Circle Right. Added: Figure 8. Posts to be 12 feet apart.

<u>Novice A</u> – No person who has previously exhibited a dog that has earned a <u>CDX</u> title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. <u>Stand for examination</u> will be done <u>off</u> leash.

<u>Novice Intermediate</u> – Drop from heel has been moved to follow Stand for Examination. Both a command and signal are allowed for the drop. Honor Exercise: removed. Replaced with Recall over the High Jump holding the Dumbbell.

<u>Open A</u> – Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

<u>Open B</u> – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approx 30 minutes prior to judging.

<u>Utility A</u> – For dogs which have not earned the title of U.D. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercise will be performed in the usual order.

<u>Utility B</u> – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approx 30 minutes prior to judging.

INFORMATION REGARDING CGN TESTING

NOTE: DOGS DO NOT NEED TO BE PUREBRED FOR THIS TEST. ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO 4 HOURS OF JUDGING. 5-8 DOGS CAN BE JUDGED PER HOUR.

POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE TESTING SITE IF THERE IS TIME Tests include the following exercises:

Tests merade the folio mig energies:	
1. Accepting a friendly stranger	7. Come when called
2. Politely accepts petting	8. Praise and interaction
3. Appearance and grooming	9. Reaction to passing dog
4. Out for a walk	10. Reaction to distractions
5.Walking through a crowd	11. Supervised isolation
6. Sit/down and stay in place	12. Walking through a door/gate

Brief description of exercises:

1. Evaluator will approach the handler and dog, greet the handler and shake hands. Dog calmly allows stranger to approach, handler is in control and dog is not threatened by the approach of a stranger.

- 2. Dog allows a stranger to pet it in a calm manner.
- 3. Dog will accept being groomed and examined. Dog is being tested for shyness or resentment.
- 4. Dog demonstrates the ability to walk politely on a **loose** leash not necessarily "formal" healing.
- 5. Tests the dog's ability to walk politely beside the handler in pedestrian traffic.
- 6. Dog's ability to sit or down and to remain in place on command.
- 7. A long line is used for this exercise. Dog must return to handler when called.
- 8. Handler plays with dog. Dog is to respond quickly to handler's command to settle. The command "Sit" or any other command can be used.
- 9. Dog will be approached by another leashed dog and a person and must only exhibit casual interest and remain under control.
- 10. Dog will be exposed to visual and auditory distractions carried by several people.
- 11. Dog will be left with someone else while the handler goes out of sight. Dog should remain calm until the owner returns.

12. Handler walks through door/gate. Dog waits to be called through. Handler's to bring:

- Proof of Vaccination certificate
- Dog License •
- Test fee \$25.00/dog (if not prepaid) .
- A 6 foot leash with dog wearing a buckle, slip or martingale collar made out of nylon, ٠ fabric, leather or chain.
- A grooming tool
- A plastic bag for picking up after your dog. ٠
